## What's Been Happening?

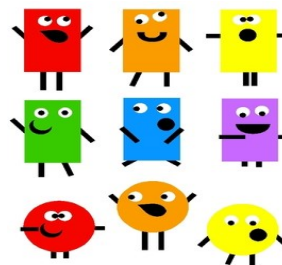

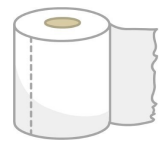
