

Why did we doo it?

en nature calls, we answer

 84 million dogs taking up residence in the US collectively deposit 62.7 million lbs of waste every day and 22.9 trillion lbs every year. This is the equivalent of 284,000 tractor trailers fully loaded to maximum weight capacity with dog poop.

• From an environmental perspective, unscooped dog poop has the biggest impact on our waterways.




The Doody-Free Water Project

How doo we doo it?

- The areas that generate the most interest and support will be the ones that receive the most bags.
- Dog parks and greenways will be selected based on several factors, including the dog park or greenway's proximity to local waterways, public accessibility, estimated bag usage and expressed need.
- The ideal recipient would be a bustling dog park or greenway that is located near water, that is widely used by the community, yet has little or no pet waste support provided by park management.











The Pet Waste Management Industry & Clean Water

- The Elizabeth River Project
- Hampton Roads DoodyCalls donated 7 pet waste stations
- The Elizabeth River Project purchased 20 pet waste stations
- DoodyCalls has provided service and bags since 2011
- Since the start of the project over 120,000 bags have been used
- Over 45,000 lbs of dog waste has been removed from the environment



Government & Private Sector Collaboration

- Education focusing on residents and common interest communities (HOA, UOA, and COA), multi-family communities
- 98% of our new customers have never used a pooper scooper service
- Recognition for common interest communities and multi-family communities that have implemented a Pet Waste Management Plan.
