RETROTHON TOURNAMENT RULES Last Updated August 25, 2016

You only need to register for one event to participate.

It will be a single elimination tournament.

A coin flip occurs and the coin flip loser will pick the two teams for the game.

Players will then alternate choices by removing a game they don't want to play until they get to two games left. The remaining games will be assigned 'Heads' and 'Tails'. A coin flip will determine the game to be played.

Example:

Coin is flipped and Player A loses the coin toss. Player A will end up picking the two teams in the game.

- 1. Player A elects to remove NHL'94 Sega
- 2. Player B elects to remove NHL'94 SNES
- 3. Player A elects to remove R.B.I. Baseball
- 4. Player B elects to remove NBA JAM T.E. Sega

NBA JAM T.E. SNES is assigned 'Heads' and Tecmo Super Bowl is assigned 'Tails'.

The coin is flipped again. "Tails" is the result.

Tecmo Super Bowl is the game to be played and Player A would select the teams to be used with Player B choosing their team.

**Alternatively, if both players want to play the same game, then they can proceed to do so.

In the Retrothon tournament, called team matchups do not carry over, so you can pick the same match up throughout.
