Don't forget to set your clock back one hour at 2:00 a.m. on Sunday morning, November 1st


(Hint: you can actually do this before you go to bed on Saturday night, so you won't have to wake up during the night to change it! 😊)

New Safety Protocols at KCOG

Our Church of God State Office has advised that churches need to stop meeting together for the next few weeks, or If the church is to stay open, to implement certain protocols to keep our members safe. Therefore, along with the previous social distancing practices we have been observing at KCOG, we are implementing new protocols for everyone's safety.

For instance, if you are sick, or are experiencing any of the symptoms of Covid-19, please stay home and watch the livestream of our services.

We will have no group meetings until further notice. There will be no Sunday School, children's church, youth meetings, Wednesday night Bible study or other group meetings at the church. (See "Keep in Contact During Quarantine" for online opportunities.)

We will continue to practice social distancing, staying at least six feet from others. This includes the aisles in the sanctuary, Welcome Center area and hallways. Please do not gather together in groups.

Every other pew is being taped off. If you see a pew taped off please do not remove the tape. Sit in a pew that is designated for seating.

Also, in order to stay open, it is imperative that everyone wear a mask from your car to the place where you sit, and then back to your car after the service. We would encourage you to keep the mask on during worship, but If you feel you must take it off you may.

If you are uncomfortable with this protocol, please stay home and watch the livestream. It is our intent to protect everyone to the best of our ability to prevent anyone from contracting Covid-19 at our church, and so that we may continue to have open services.

Thank you for helping others stay safe, and for keeping a loving, Christian attitude!
