
# Wyoming State Muzzleloader Association's News December, 2017


Looking forward to seeing everyone at the annual WSMLA convention. Wishing everyone a Merry Christmas and Happy New Year; along with safe travels.

### Categories:

Please try to have your photos turned in at the photo contest table by 10:30 A.M. on Saturday January 6th. Remember, the earlier you have it on display, the more time people will have for voting on your entry. Limit of three photos per category per person.

## CLUBS AT THE LOCAL LEVEL:


What is your club doing? Send me pictures, stories, and articles on what your local club is doing and I will publish it in the newsletter.

They were taught how the muzzle loader can either be a flint lock or a percussion, and what the difference is between a pistol and a revolver.
