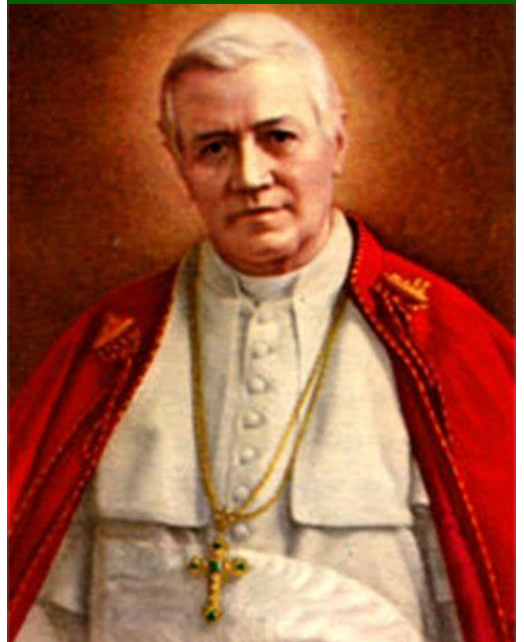
The people of Lebanon were already dealing with the effects of the COVID-19 pandemic and hosting almost one million Syrian refugees – need our assistance.
