In the individual competition, senior Acacia Fossum was all-around champion with a score of 39.067. She also won the uneven bars, 9.767; balance beam, 9.600; and floor exercise, 9.833. Fossum finished with an impressive 15 individual state titles in her career. Keana Kudrna won the vault, 9,900.
