Dear Awana Parents,

We pray that this letter finds you all well. We just want to take a moment to update you with everything that is happening with our Awana program. I recently recorded a video and posted it on the church's Facebook page—Awana Club of Cameron First Baptist Church. In this video, we announced that the remainder of the Awana year will be completed at home if able. This is an opportunity for children that want to finish learning their verses, to complete their books.

In the video, we lead parents through some Awana basics on how to help your child best learn from home and how to lead him or her through individual sections of the book.
