The regular November meeting of the Summerfield Township Planning Commission was called to order on November 12, 2018, by Chairperson Amy Reiter at 7:00 p.m.

1. Medical Marijuana Home Occupation: Chairperson Amy Reiter indicated that a recent home occupation medical marijuana lawsuit expanded the home occupation locations. It was suggested that we wait for further clarification before acting.

2. Wineries: The next new business was a discussion relative to a request by J. Trees Cellars Cidery & Winery to amend our Ordinance Article 15.310 to allow it to charge for wine tasting at its premises, to consume wine on site purchased at the winery and to sell food related to the wines on site. There were no objections to the proposed amendments to Paragraphs 4, 5 and 6 of Article 15.310. Chairperson Amy Reiter is to work on language to amend Article 15.310.
