Office “Re-Opening” Planning Underway

As various segments of the Community begin the process of getting back to normal, the Staff at BWD has begun the process of thinking through the changes it will need to make to safely open the Office to public access. Although no definitive date has been set yet, once the office is opened up again you will see the following changes:

- Plastic protective barriers will be installed at Front Counter
- Hand sanitizing stations have been installed at all Entrances
- Face masks will be required
- Social Distancing: A limit of one customer at a time
- Frequent sanitizing of office

The exact date of re-opening the office will be determined by BWD Board and Staff based on recommendations from Regulatory Agencies.
