## **Havoc Teams**

Each elementary and middle school-aged team will have a full slate of tournaments over the next 3 and a half months (outside of the newly formed 4th grade team). The 2022 (9th Grade) team has completed tryouts and will compete all the way into July.

### Congratulations to Havoc 2022's Julia Wilson

Congratulations to freshman Julia Wilson ('22) for being selected to 2nd Team All-Conference in the TCIS. She is the school's first freshman player to receive the honor. For the season, Julia averaged 14.3 points/game, which was third highest in the conference and 12.9 rebounds/game, which was second highest in the conference. In 19 games, Julia recorded 12 double-doubles (double digit points and double digit rebounds) and broke a 25 year-old school record by grabbing 26 rebounds in a single game.

Julia is in her 6th season playing for Havoc, and blossomed into a tremendous player. Looking forward to another solid season with Julia manning the post.
