GREEN DOMINANT IN CAPTURING FIRST TOUR TITLE

BREAKTHROUGH PERFORMANCE GARNERS BIGGEST VICTORY OF CAREER

GREEN WINS WITH DOMINANT DISPLAY OF SPEED & POWER

Joshua Green became a brand new GISBT champion at this month's tour stop at Big River Bowling in Davenport. He turned back the year's strongest starting field, and he did it in dominant fashion. The 2-hander from Baton Rouge, Louisiana used a combination of speed and power to overwhelm the field. This was Green's 7th tour appearance, but his first time qualifying for the match play finals; he certainly made the most of the opportunity.

The champion set a fast pace in qualifying by averaging 229.50 for his 8 game block; this enabled him to enter match play with a 70-pin lead. Once the finals moved over to freshly oiled conditions for the finals, the pattern got even more challenging. Green posted a 198.12 average for his 8 games, but this enabled him to earn 7 wins and a tie in 8 matches, and his lead seemed to grow with each match. He averaged 213.7 for his 16 games, with his final margin of victory being 223 pins.

CHAMP BECOMES 130th DIFFERENT BOY'S CHAMPION IN TOUR HISTORY

Green took home a \$500 scholarship award for his breakthrough victory. He became the 130th different boy's champion in the history of the GISBT, which has now encompassed 292 tournaments. Congratulations, Josh!

85 PLAYERS TURN OUT FOR REGULAR-SEASON FINALE

85 competitors turned out for the final event of the 2021-2022 season. The field was the largest of the season, and also the strongest, featuring 13 past champions and 41 players who had appeared in at least 1 match play finals so far in their career. We welcome 7 brand new members who were making their GISBT debut this month, and welcome back to our returning members as well!

4-TIME CHAMP SIKKEMA EARNS RUNNER-UP FINISH

Seth Sikkema returned to the tour in fine form, as the talented 2-hander from Fulton, Illinois surged up the standings late in match play to secure the runner-up spot. Sikkema fired a 223 in the final game of qualifying to sneak into the finals, and then after 3 games, he found himself mired in 8th place before averaging 221 over the final 5 games, winning all 5 matches, to surge into the runner-up position. The 4-time tour winner was appearing in his 18th match play finals, and he took home a \$400 scholarship by virtue of his performance.

PAST CHAMP ROTH PLACES 3rd

Corey Roth hauled in a \$300 scholarship by finishing 3rd at this month's event. One of 4 2-handers in this month's boy's finals field, the Coralville, Iowa resident was appearing in the 7th match play finals of his career. He was returning to Big River Bowling for the first time since he captured his GISBT championship there at the 2021-2022 season opener in August.

VANVEGHEL 4th IN MATCH PLAY DEBUT

River Vanveghel advanced to the first match play finals of his promising career. The talented right-hander from Waterloo, Illinois came away with an impressive 4th place showing, netting a \$250 scholarship for his efforts.

DENTON'S 5th PLACE FINISH SECURES BOWLER OF THE YEAR

Zack Denton qualified for the 8th match play finals of his career at this month's event. This proved to be the most significant finals appearance of his career, however, as his performance enabled him to earn enough points to capture his first Bowler of the Year Award.

Denton's finish earned a \$225 scholarship and allowed him to earn enough points to overtake leader Joshua Collins by just 6 points for top honors in one of the closest finishes in tour history. This is Denton's 2nd consecutive All Star Team appearance; he finished 3rd in the 2020-2021 point standings.

MONNENS TAKES 6th

Jordan Monnens was this month's 6th place finisher. The southpaw from Ham Lake, Minnesota took home a \$200 scholarship for his day's work. It was the 5th match play finals appearance of his career.

ABOUD EARNS 7th

Justin Aboud returned to the match play finals for the 6th time in his tour career. The San Jose, California resident earned a \$175 scholarship award by finishing in 7th place.

COOK PLACES 8th

Jake Cook rounded out this month's match play finalists. The right-hander from Keokuk, Iowa was returning to the match play finals for the 2nd time in his career; he took home a \$150 for his 8th place finish.

MOORE WINS TITLE # 2

MOORE RETURNS TO GISBT WINNER'S CIRCLE FOR 2nd TIME

It took Rachel Moore 43 GISBT events to capture her first tour title; that came in this past September's event in Waterloo. It took her just 5 more events to record her 2nd championship.

Moore qualified 3rd in a tightly bunched finals field, and posted a 4-2 record in match play that allowed her to remain in contention throughout a very challenging match play finals segment of the competition. Despite her 185-165 position round loss to runner-up Tricia Alvarado, the Keokuk, Iowa resident clung to a 7-pin margin of victory. She averaged 193.35 for her 14 games and hauled in a \$400 scholarship. Congratulations, Rachel!

ALVARADO EARNS RUNNER-UP SPOT

Tricia Alvarado earned the highest finish of her tour career at this month's event. The right-hander from Bakersfield, California came up just 7 pins short in her quest for a GISBT title, but instead settled for the runner-up finish. She took home a \$300 scholarship for her day's work.

3-TIME CHAMP NELSON RETURNS FOR 3rd PLACE FINISH

3-time tour champion Addy Nelson logged a 3rd place finish this month. Nelson has competed in 14 tour events in her career, and has now qualified for the finals 13 times. The Gregory, South Dakota resident received a \$225 scholarship for her high finish.

Gabi Evans was this month's 4th place finisher. The West Liberty, Iowa native earned a \$200 scholarship for her performance. This was the 11th match play finals of her stellar career.

MORSE FINISHES 5th

Whitney Morse returned to the match play finals for the 12th time in her tour career at this month's stop. The Muscatine, Iowa resident hauled in a \$175 scholarship for her day's work. In opening ceremonies, Morse was recognized for becoming the 63rd player in tour annals to roll in 50 GISBT events.
