

Judson G. McDonnell, 55, of Bad Axe, formerly of Howell, passed away on October 5, 2016 from injuries from an automobile accident.

Jud was born on October 21, 1960 in Washington D.C. to Terrence and Noreen (McVey) McDonnell.
