THE EASTER SEASON: The Easter season is celebrated during the seven weeks between Easter and Pentecost. Called "the Great Sunday" by Saint Athanasius, these fifty days of Easter are celebrated as one great Feast Day. These days, above all others, are the days for the singing of the Alleluia and so, throughout the entire Easter season, Christians sing the triumphant "Alleluia" as they continue to rejoice in the hope of the resurrection.

Sunday's Theme

The Ascension of Jesus reminds us that we **I** are pilgrims on a journey, that we are "only passing through" on this earth. Meanwhile, like the apostles, we have work to do. In the readings from the Acts of the Apostles and the Gospel, Jesus tells the apostles that they are witnesses. So too are we. Like the apostles, we are challenged to witness to Christ in our daily lives in our homes, in our churches, in our local community, and, yes, even to the ends of the



earth. What a wonderful privilege this is as sons and daughters of God!

FEAST OF THE VISITATION OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY (May 31st)



This feast commemorates the meeting between the Blessed Virgin Mary and her cousing the Blessed Virgin Mary and her cousin Elizabeth, both of whom find themselves with child. Each woman experiences an outpouring of the Holy Spirit. Elizabeth's response is to declare Mary and her child blessed; Mary's response is to utter the great hymn of praise, the Magnificat. Found in Saint Luke's Gospel (Luke 1.39-56), the whole event is one of rejoicing in the wonders that God has done.

MAY 29 - WORLD COMMUNICATIONS DAY: Today Catholics are invited to reflect upon the media of social communication (films, radio, television, newspapers, audiovisuals) and how these influence our lives and promote values that lead to a more fully human society. The Church's ministry is twofold. The media can be used to help promote the Gospel. At the same time, as receivers of the materials presented by the media, the faithful have a duty to support and promote worthwhile presentations on media and to reject those which promote values contrary to spiritual growth.

June 1 - MEMORIAL OF SAINT JUSTIN, MARTYR: Justin was a convert to Christianity and was called "The Philosopher". He used his knowledge of philosophy to explain Christian doctrine. Eventually, he was brought to trial and martyred about the year 165. The official account from court records still exists and shows how Justin and his companions, when brought before the Roman prefect, declared themselves to be Christian, refused to sacrifice to the gods, and were subsequently condemned to death. Justin's writings include one of the earliest descriptions of the Mass.
