At 348 miles long, the James River is the 12th largest river in the United States that is based entirely in one state: Virginia. This weekend will allow 4-H campers to experience the James River and learn about the fun it provides for us. How much does this camp cost?

Realizing that families have differing abilities to pay, we are offering a voluntary 3-tier pricing program at the 4-H Center. Please take a moment to look at the rate descriptions below and determine which of the prices your family is able & willing to pay for your child's camp experience.

The first price (\$75) is our historically subsidized rate (\$90) is a partially subsidized rate (\$105) represents the true cost of camp.

This program is voluntary (you choose the price), and in no way influences the quality of experience each child receives.

Additional financial assistance may be available to ensure all children have this wonderful opportunity to attend camp.

Teen counselors will not be charged a fee as long as they have undergone appropriate 4-H trainings and are selected to be within a 1:8 counselor to camper ratio. Additional teens will be charged \$30.00.

How old is my camper?

Youth 9-13 years of age may attend. Youth must reach their ninth birthday by September 30, 2015 and must not have reached their fourteenth birthday before the first day of the camp.

What about volunteering?

Where is the camp?

Jamestown 4-H Center is located on the beautiful James River, just one mile from Jamestown Island and the Colonial Parkway, and five miles from Colonial Williamsburg. It is an easy drive from anywhere in Hampton Roads or Richmond.
