Mr. Edwin A. Stein, 93, of Harbor Beach, passed away Friday, Feb. 21, 2003, at the Marlette Community Hospital Hospice Residence. Edwin was born on Jan. 8, 1910 in Ruth to the late Edward J. and Elizabeth (Pickron) Stein. He married Irene O'Neil on Sept. 15, 1934 at Sts. Peter & Paul Catholic Church in Ruth. Edwin was a graduate of the Pumpkin Center Sherman #1 Country School. He worked on the Great Lakes from 1930 to 1934.
