 and is enjoying being supported by a wonderful team.



Covid-19 Pandemic -We want to say a massive thank you and well done to our amazing staff team who have pulled together and worked hard throughout this difficult time.


We recently held a Lockdown competition for all our staff, asking them to send in photos of their newly found hobbies and skills. Here are some of the fabulous entries.....




before putting a plastic coating on to act as a mouse mat verv talented indeed!

Our in house trainers have delivered 11 in house and 4 external courses since January 2020!



During lockdown Arnold has managed to stay active with the encouragement of his staff.




Our new service user Tony has enjoyed taking part in lots of activities with his new staff, he has helped with the cooking and baking, gardening and shopping.

Junaid is still managing to have lots of fun whilst staying in, especially when Yvonne brings her exciting bag of tricks.




Home Schooling
