The SCS strives to facilitate a safe competition setting and help foster agricultural production projects across breeders and youth. The SCS also is committed to helping fund higher education opportunities to promote and foster future agricultural leaders.

GENERAL INFORMATION/RULES:

- 1. All CJLA exhibitors must be ages 19 and under as of January 1, 2017.
- 2. Entry fees per Show:

0	Goats -	\$30 per entry
0	Sheep -	\$30 per entry
0	Hogs –	\$30 per entry
0	Wether Dam Does -	\$30 per entry
0	Cattle -	\$35 per entry
0	Showmanship -	\$10 per entry
0	Sheep, Goat, Hog Pens-	\$10 per pen
0	Cattle Stalls	\$5 per head
0	RV Spot	\$25 per night

3. Entries must be postmarked by April 17, 2017. Late entries will be accepted prior to the show, provided space permits. Late entries will be charged an additional fee.

- 4. ALL CJLA RULES APPLY!!
- 5. Policies and selection of judges rest solely with the management.
- 6. There will be NO REFUNDS on entries paid to the Spring Classic Stockshow.
- 7. Management reserves the right to change anything that will better accommodate and/or improve the show.
- 8. Each exhibitor must show his/her own animal. Any exception must be approved prior to the show by the show management. If, and only if, a showman is currently showing one animal and has another animal to show simultaneously, an alternate showman is acceptable.
- 9. The exhibitor will need to provide bedding. Clean up will be mandatory. Local FFA group will be providing assistance for clean up. Please use designated dumping areas only!!



- 10. Ethical treatment of all animals and ethical conduct from the exhibitor is expected at the Spring Classic Stockshow.
- 11. Any animal exhibiting signs of infectious or unsightly conditions **WILL NOT BE PERMITTED** to show at the Spring Classic Stockshow. Vet check will occur at weigh-ins.
- 12. Any animal that is deemed a safety hazard by show management will be disqualified with no refund.
- 13. PLEASE bring generators power is limited.
- 14. No dogs will be allowed at or around the show ring.
- 15. OUT OF STATE EXHIBITORS MUST have appropriate health inspections! Paperwork checked in at weigh-in/vet check.
- 16. Payouts will depend on the success of the show. All expenses must be paid prior to payouts being decided or disbursed. The Spring Classic Stockshow is self-sustaining and ran independently on entry fees and sponsorships alone.

Market Beef, Hog, Goat & Sheep Shows

- Official weigh-in will take place Friday evening from 5:00 PM 7:00 PM as well as Saturday morning from 7:00 – 8:30 AM. An additional weigh-in will take place Sunday from 7:30-8:00 AM for animals being shown on Sunday only!
- 2. Animals must be entered in Show A to be eligible for Show A Showmanship and entered in Show B to be eligible for Show B Showmanship.
- 3. The Market shows will have three divisions: Prospect, Progress and Market. Classes will be broken down and posted the day of the show following official weigh-in.
- 4. Market Hog show will include both market barrows and market gilts.
- 5. Market Sheep show will include both market wethers and market ewes.
- 6. Market Goat show will include both market wethers and market does that are dehorned
- 7. Market Beef show will include classes in following breeds: Black & Black-X, English, All other Color, and Market Heifers.
- 8. Entries in the Market Beef English class are required to show registration paperwork at checkin.

Breeding Beef Show

- Official check-in will take place Friday evening from 5:00-7:00 PM, Saturday evening 5:00 7:00 PM, as well as Sunday morning 7:00 – 8:30 AM.
- 2. Breeding Beef Show will include classes in following breeds: Angus, Charolais, Hereford, Maine Anjou & Mainetainer, Shorthorn, All Other Purebred, and Percentage.
- 3. All Heifers must be registered and show registration paperwork at check-in and be registered in the exhibitor's name only.

Wether Dam Doe

1. Wether dam does CANNOT be dual entered in Market Goat Show and in the Wether Dam Show.



- 2. All wether dam classes will be broken by weight.
- 3. Official weigh-in will take place at same times as the official Market weigh-ins.
- 4. This is a replacement program. All does must resemble the maternal line of a meat goat.
- 5. Does may be shown with or without horns and may be shown with or without being slick shorn.
- 6. All does and ewes must have an ear tag or permanent legible tattoo, prior to weigh-in.
- 7. All does must have milk teeth or yearling teeth.
- 8. Structural correctness disqualifications are at the discretion of the judge.
- 9. Wether Dam Does are eligible for Wether Dam Doe Showmanship.

Showmanship

- 1. Showmanship (age as of January 1, 2017): Junior Division (12 & under) Intermediate Division (13-15) and Senior Division (16-19).
- 2. All exhibitors must show their own animal. NO EXCEPTIONS!!!
- 3. Exhibitor must have an animal entered in the Show A to be eligible for Show A Showmanship, entered in Show B for Show B Showmanship.
- 4. Wether Dam Doe showmanship will take place before the Wether Dam Doe
- 5. Fitting is optional for showmanship!!

Champion Showmanship Competition

- 1. Champion & Reserve Junior, Intermediate, and Senior Showmen for all market showmanship will all compete in one ring for Champion Species Showman
 - a. Champion Sheep Showman
 - b. Champion Beef Showman
 - c. Champion Swine Showman
 - d. Champion Goat Showman
- 2. Each qualifying exhibitor will be automatically entered into the Champion Showmanship Competition. If exhibitor fails to compete they forfeit their premiums and prizes connected to showmanship.
- 3. Pee Wee Showmanship will compete in species of choice.
 - a. No prior entry needed. Each Pee Wee exhibitor just needs to show up ringside of the species they chose to compete in at 6:30.
 - b. Age qualification for Pee Wee Showmanship is under the age of 9 as of the day of competition.
 - c. No exhibitor that has competed in a showmanship earlier in the day can compete in Pee Wee Showmanship.
