## **RTA Rules of Conduct**

The guidelines below will provide the framework necessary to ensure that RTA's riding and hiking privileges on private and public space are preserved.

- 1. The rights of the property owners, across whose land we are permitted to ride/hike must be respected at all times. Remember that you are a guest on the land. When you meet landowners, be courteous and let them know how much you appreciate the pleasure they are providing you. One irresponsible person can cause the permanent closure of a trail.
- 2. Ride/hike the Association trails only. Riders and hikers must not wander from marked trails and must stay close to the edge of farmer's fields. You must respect "Trail closed" signs. Do not use any landowners' schooling facilities, jumps, training tracks, playing fields, etc.
- 3. No motorized vehicles are permitted on the trails.
- 4. Hikers must keep pets on a leash at all times.
- 5. Please report any damage or repairs needed to trails/fences throughout the year to the trail maintenance representative.
- 6. Riders are strongly encouraged to wear helmets and proper riding shoes/boots. Junior riders 18 and under must wear approved safety helmets and proper riding boots.
- 7. Be thoughtful of landowner's privacy. Dress appropriately and keep voices down. Walk your horse down any driveway or trail that passes close to a house, or by any pasture where you might disturb livestock.
- 8. Active participation to help maintain trails and support the organization is required of all members.
- 9. No use of trails after daylight hours.
- 10. Do not ride trails in groups larger than 6 or hike in groups larger than 8.
- 11. No littering, cooking/fires, camping or smoking on the trails.
- 12. Please display your RTA membership tag while on the trails.
- 13. All riders MUST wear blaze orange during hunting season.
- 14. Please be courteous and remove any manure from the road when safe/possible.
