How many times have you heard that? Whether it is an insurance company, a doctor's office, a car repair center or a myriad of other places – we need to talk to someone else or get permission from another entity. After a while we may feel frustrated and begin to feel we can do nothing on our own. In the long run, it can break down our dignity and confidence in making our own decisions or following the advice that we most trust. And our society encourages that more and more!

The good news is that our God is NOT like that! Our God...

- ...tells us "Before I formed you in the womb I knew you" (Jer 1:5a)
- ...created us in God's own image, "male and female we were created" (Gen 1:27)
- ...reminds us "that we are precious and honored in God's sight because God loves us" (Is 43:4)

Curveball! By Annette Brooks, Program Director

As you read this, we are in the liturgical season of Lent, and, although we are

still in the season of Winter, that season will be quickly moving into the season of Spring. As you know there are also seasons in life: birth, death ... "for everything there is a season, and a time for every matter under heaven" (Ecclesiastes 3:1).

In our seasons of life on our journey of living, we occasionally encounter a "curveball." A "curveball" has been referred to as something that is unexpected, or an unexpected turn of events. Have you ever encountered a "curveball" in your life? If you did, how did you handle it? Over the last couple of months, I was thrown a "curveball." It definitely forced me to stop and take time to reflect, and to share with God what I was feeling and experiencing. I looked to God for support and for understanding of the unexpected events that had impacted my life. It was during this time that I came upon this Scripture from the Letter of St. Paul to the Romans: "Rejoice in hope, be patient under trial, persevere in prayer" (Romans 12:12).

I have sat and prayed with that Scripture on numerous occasions since then. I have come to realize how very true and accurate that scripture is. I can rejoice in hope, since my hope is in the Lord, and it is the Lord who will provide for me. For He knows the plans that He has for me, to give me life. As it says in the Book of Jeremiah, "For I know the plans that I have for you,' declares the LORD, 'plans for

well-being, and not for calamity, in order to give you a future and a hope." (Jer. 29:11) With that in mind, I am so very fortunate that I have a God who cares for my well-being and holds me when "curveballs" are encountered.

The verse from the Letter to the Romans actually tells me how to proceed when I encounter a "curveball":

- 1. Rejoice in the hope of the Lord,
- 2. Have patience when dealing with the event,
- 3. and finally Pray

I am not saying that it is easy, but by following those three steps, I believe that one will be able to get through a "curveball" event in one's life. As one lives through a "curveball," one's trust in the Lord also deepens and becomes stronger.




