


These blueberry and lemon buttermilk scones have a sugary, crispy crust, a soft and pillowy middle, and pockets of juicy, exploding blueberries. In other words, they're insanely delicious. The fruit is interchangeable so use whatever you like. But you really can't beat blueberry + lemon.

INGREDIENTS

2 1/2 c. flour 1/2 c. sugar 2 1/2 tsp. baking powder 1 tsp. salt 1 stick cold butter, cut into cubes 1 c. blueberries 1 tsp. lemon zest 1 large egg, beaten 2/3 c. buttermilk 1/2 tsp. almond extract 1/2 tsp. vanilla extract 2 tbsp. melted butter, for brushing






DIRECTIONS

Preheat oven to 400° and line a large baking sheet with parchment paper. In a large bowl, whisk together flour, sugar, baking powder, and salt. Add butter and use your hands (or a pastry cutter) to cut butter into flour until crumbles are the size of peas. Add blueberries and lemon zest and toss to coat.

Make a well in mixture, then add buttermilk, egg, and extracts. Mix with your hands until just combined. Turn dough out onto a lightly floured surface and pat into an 8" circle. Cut into 8 triangles and place on prepared baking sheet. Brush scones with melted butter and sprinkle with coarse sugar. Freeze for 10 minutes. bake until lightly golden, about 25 minutes. Let cool 5 minutes then transfer to a cooling rack to cool completely. Enjoy!
