# HOW TO PICK THE RIGHT ARBORIST

- Pick a tree service that has been in the tree business for a while. If someone pulls up to your home in a dilapidated truck with unmarked equipment and odd looking workers, watch out!
- Ask about the company's insurance coverage. If necessary, request that a certificate of insurance be addressed to you. Remember, in the case of any accident on your property without proper insurance you will have to pay the bill.
- Inquire about the credentials of the person who does the diagnostic work, pesticide recommendations and estimating. Ask about how long the climber has been working professionally. **Ask if the climber is an ISA Certified Arborist.** A combination of education and experience assures you of an accurate diagnosis and recommendation of what should be done and how it should be done right.
- Never hire a company that does not have the proper knowledge of pruning your delicate trees. Climbers must use spurless techniques while pruning these. Spurs can severely injure your trees that need pruning if they are used, causing infection and injuring the bark.
- Ask if they use hardhats, eye protection and ear protection when necessary.
- Ask about the drug testing program the company has in order to insure the safety of the worker and the homeowner.
- Be suspicious to a low price estimate compared to a higher priced estimate. All responsible companies operate under approximately the same cost structure, assuming that they are properly insured, they are working safely with the proper equipment and that they are paying to attract competent, smart tree workers that know what they are doing.
- Ask for names of some property owners in the area that have used a tree company recently that can give you a reference.
- Finally, deal with someone that is going to be around next year and for many years after that to carry out plans of action on maintaining your trees and shrubs. Many low priced companies that look cheap normally are, they do poor work then go out of business because of it. Picking a good tree service will benefit you for many years to come.
