Survivors of trauma can experience a wide variety of normal reactions to a traumatic event.


These reactions can include:

Adolescent, Adult & Family Services

Individual and Family Counseling

Our professional licensed therapists, serve children and adolescents (between the ages of 4 and 18) and all adults. We specialize in adult trauma services, marriage counseling and EMDR Therapy.

Play Therapy

Therapists work with young children's social and emotional development as well as resolving early trauma including physical or sexual abuse and any unresolved trauma.

Sexually Reactive Youth

We provide early intervention with youth who display disruptive and aggressive sexualized behaviors toward self and other adolescents.

Outpatient Drug & Alcohol Services

Our therapists & counselors aid families, who are struggling with substance abuse in both individual and group settings. The primary goal is prevention and intervention services.

Parenting Classes

We provide a loving curriculum that allows each parent to learn parenting techniques that are more comfortable and effective for the child and parent. We learn from the evidence based curriculum "Love & Logic" and from each other. Classes offered monthly, both volunteer and court ordered.

LGBTQ Community

We have experienced counselors to help you navigate to recovery and wellness regardless of sexual identity or gender expression.

Adult Groups:

Life Skills, Anger Management & Substance Abuse Groups. We offer three different 12 week adult groups for court ordered individuals, Sliding fee scale available.

Adolescent Groups:

Life Skills, Violence Intervention & Substance Abuse Group. We offer three different adolescent groups volunteer or court ordered.

Teen & Truancy Court

Teen Court is a first time offender's program that assigns constructive consequences from a jury of their peers (other adolescents) that is designed to help the adolescent defendant learn from their mistakes and be held accountable without having to go before a formal court of law.

Outreach

Desert View determines the underserved populations in San Juan County and develops strategies to reach these populations; examples of underserved populations may include adolescents; people of color; LGBT community; people with disabilities, and others.

UA's: Urine analysis with immediate results. On-Site, dip-type drug tests – Test checks for Marijuana, Meth, Cocaine, Opiates, and PCP.

Cost: We accept Medicaid and most private insurances. If a family does not have either, we have financial assistance that may cover your services; we also use a sliding fee scale.

- threatened or forced
- ♦ unconscious
- ♦ intoxicated
- unable to consent in any circumstance for any reason

Sexual assault is a crime of violence, power and control.

At Desert View, we offer survivor centered trauma services including therapeutic counseling. Without proper care, traumatic events can lead to an increased likelihood of developing substance abuse, addiction, anxiety and depression that may interfere with daily levels of functioning. We treat various types of trauma including Veterans.
