## The OVSC Summit is a matter of record – FY14 OVSC offerings are a lock(s). Start your engines!

**Lock 1**: **Croatia** – the treasures of the Adriadic Coast. Second week September 2013. Zagreb; 4star hotel; Zadar-Sibenik-Split-Togar-Mostar-Dubrovnik. Pricing is being worked; this won't be free but will be a 'chance of a lifetime' - stay tuned. Extension: **Istanbul!** First week September 2013: St.Sophia; Hippodrome; Blue Mosque; Grand Covered Bazaar; Topkapi Palace; Suleymaniye Mosque; Spice Bazaar; Bosphorous bridge and excursion; Beylerbeyi Palace; Dolmabache Palace and Underground Cistern. Pricing: tbd – stay tuned.

Lock 2: Telluride, 18 – 25 January 2013. Luxurious, slope-side accommodations (with all amenities). Outstanding skiing and adventure for everyone. Telluride is definitely a place one must experience more than once. Four years ago it was profoundly great. Given 'inflation' and escalating, in-flux air fairs, this may come in at ~\$1,700 for the week. Expensive? Perhaps, but outstanding, ski-in-ski-out accommodations – a great value and venue.

Lock 3: Mt Bachelor, 1 – 8 March 2013. Currently the 'land package' is \$889! Air seats available for \$550 into Portland – three and a half hours by bus to Bend via Mt Hood and a rain forest. Final air details are being worked. Option to fly into Redman (20 minutes away) is being considered. This will be (guaranteed!) a really great, memorable trip. An OVSC 'first'! and the OVSC will be one of the first councils ever to invade Mt Bachelor. The 'Bachelor Group Services Team' (of 'Bachelorettes') is eagerly awaiting our being there and ready to be overwhelmingly accommodating. The 'hospitality' will be unmatched by anything we've seen before – guaranteed! One of the top ten in the nation for skiable acres (3,683), vertical distance (3,365), and annual snowfall (387").
