Board hires architect and seeks pastor

The board of trustees voted Oct. 14 to approve a \$32,100 bid from Gary Hawkins, a Chico architect, for design services to build a church facility.

The initial bid includes construction drawing, planning submittal, color rendering, structural engineering and required energy calculations.
