



SAPPHIRE (*OMAN x *SZIKRA) 1991 mare
Breeder: Petra Gorski, Owner: Adele Furby
154 (15.1)-197-18.5 7,7,8,7,7,7
Not quite typical Shagya mare of medium size. Nice head and neck, good shoulder, broad and deep body. Good bone for her size, and correct limbs. Good topline. Ordinary walk and trot.



ALMOS (*SHANDOR x *ARRIVA), 1991 stallion
Breeder: Adele Furby, Owner: Cindy Lewis Taylor
153 (15.+)-180-19.7 7,7,7,6,7,8
Small Shagya stallion with a typey head, a bit heavy. Friendly expression, good neck and shoulder. The loin appears slightly tight. Well-developed gaskin. Good limbs with short, flat cannons, and good knees and hocks. (Deviation in right fetlock due to congenital injury.) Good straight movement with good impulsion.



BRONTE (*SHANDOR x BRAVITA) 1992 mare
Breeder: Cindy Lewis Taylor, Owner: Cindy Lewis Taylor
152 (15.0)-168-18.5 8,7,8,7,7,8
Still developing filly of very good Shagya type. Good neck, withers, and shoulder. Correct legs with good bone. Free movements with good swing and elastic back.



OMAN'S DAYDREAM (*OMAN x SAPPHIRE MELODY ox)
1991 mare (Part-Shagya-Arabian)
Breeder: Terri Lires, Owner: Hank Rothwell
154 (15.1)-179-18.5 8,8,8,6,7,8
A very pleasing mare tending toward the purebred Arabian type. Pretty head with good expression and friendly eye. Head and neck well set on. A slightly pointed croup, good shoulder. Slightly tied-in under knees. Walk a bit irregular and moving close behind. Good impulsion and rhythm at trot.



MERLIN MAGIC (*OMAN x DAALA MIRAGE ox), 1991 gelding (Part-Shagya-Arabian)
Breeder and owner: Minnetta King
154 (15.1)-190-18 7,8,7,6,6,6
An attractive gelding with a beautiful, expressive head, and kind eye. Good neck well set on a long deep shoulder. A bit long over the loin with a rather short, pointed croup. Very narrow behind. Ordinary, narrow walk. Floating trot with a good rhythm but unfortunately still very narrow.



ELL DAALDAN (*OMAN x DOLLY'S ECHO ox) 1990 gelding
Breeder: Minnetta King, Owner: Jennifer Jacob
157 (15.2)-187-18.5 8,8,7,7,7,9
A large Shagya gelding with an imposing presence. Good length of rein. A deep, well-ribbed body. The croup is a bit short and pointed. The legs are a bit fine and the knees not prominent enough, and the joints a bit small. Energetic walk and trot with good carriage.



***SHAGYA II-2 (SAPHIR I [SHAGYA II] x 85 IBN GALAL)**
1992 mare
Breeder: Babolna Stud, Owner: Adele Furby
159 (15.3)-188-19.5 9,8,8,7,8,9
A promising young mare of splendid Shagya type. A good head with a long, good neck. Long sloping shoulder. Very good limbs (but blemished left hind from a recent accident). Big walk, moving close behind. Floating rhythmic trot.



RAMONA (*OMAN x RACHELLE), 1991 mare
Breeder: Adele Furby, Owner: Cindy Lewis Taylor
155 (15.1)-179-18 7,6,7,6,6,6
Not quite typical Shagya mare with friendly eye and good neck. Well-defined withers, good depth of body. Good wither but uneven coupling. Correct legs but the joints a bit small. Good movements in walk and trot.



CZARONIX (*SHANDOR x CSILLA) 1992 colt
156 (15.1+)-179-19 9,9,8,7,7,7
Breeder: Pat Pettitt, Owner: Ron and Pat Pettitt and Mr. and Mrs. Dave Bulechek
A large, very typey, elegant Shagya colt with a masculine, expressive head set on an extremely good neck. Enough width and depth in the body for his age. Good knees and hocks but toeing out a bit due to being a bit close in the elbows. Short, unconcentrated walk and undeveloped trot.





BLOSSOM (*OMAN x *BIALA) 1990 mare
Breeder: Adele Furby, Owner: Carolyn Tucker
154 (15.1)-185-18 7,8,7,7,7,7

A pleasing young mare of good type. Feminine head and good neck. Adequate shoulder and a bit short, pointed croup. Legs a bit fine and knees not quite prominent enough. Good, even walk on the narrow side, better in trot.



SPECIAL EDITION (*BUDAPEST x MOLLY REDWING [TB])
1994 colt foal (part-Shagya)

Breeder and owner: Marsha Wilson
type 8, conformation 7, movement 7

A charming, well-muscled foal with an improved neck over the mother. A long hip and good shoulder. The legs are a bit fine and on the straight side. The movement is a bit short but with good rhythm.



ERIKA (*OMAN x DOLLY'S ECHO ox) 1991 mare

155 (15.1)-191-17.8 7,7,5,7,6,7,7

A rather big mare of good useful sort, pretty *OMAN head, good neck and shoulder. A good saddle area, the hindquarters a bit too steep and pointed croup. The legs are too fine, with capped hocks and standing narrow. Sufficient movements.



BRAVURA (*OMAN x BRAVANA) 1990 mare
Breeder: Mike and Sharon Foss, Owner: Les and Corinna Wilson

150 (14.3)-175-17.5 7,8,8,6,8,8

A rather small feminine mare with a beautiful head and neck and a kind eye. Good depth and width of chest for her size. Good length of rein. Nice and easy walk using her back very well. Trot with excellent rhythm.



FOCUS AF (*SHANDOR x FRIDA) 1991 stallion

Breeder: Adele Furby, Owner: Donja Vaughn

154 (15.1)-185-19.5 8,9,8,7,8,9

A masculine stallion of good type with an alert eye. A long, well-laid back shoulder and good depth of body. A strong hindquarter and well-developed gaskin. Flat bone, toeing out a bit in front. Energetic and elastic walk. Free rhythmic trot with good suspension.



H. BARON GYEMANT (H. BRAVO X H. KEK GYEMANT)
1988 stallion (Part-Shagya)

Breeder: Carolyn Hoff, Owner: Donja Vaughn

166 (16.1)-190-20.5 9,9,8,8,7,8

An elegant Hungarian stallion with an imposing presence. A good head set on a long, good neck. A sufficiently deep body with the withers not quite prominent enough, and back a bit on the long side. Good legs but hocks on the straight side. Rhythmic walk and trot.



***NIOBE** (BALATON x NICOLA) 1986 mare

Breeder: Andrea von Nordeck, Owners: Mr. & Mrs. Dave Bulechek & Ron and Pat Pettit

159 (15.3)-183-18 8,8,7,6,7,7

A Shagya mare with an elegant neck, a well-defined wither and good depth of body and a nice long hip, but the body a bit narrow. The bone a little fine, the knees not prominent enough, and the hocks a bit straight. Adequate movement (just-trimmed feet).



FELICITY (*OMAN x MAY FOLLY ox) 1990 mare

Breeder: Paul and Marty Morgan, Owners: Pat Burge and Dick Vessel

150 (14.3)-183-18.5 7,8,7,6,8,7

A small feminine mare with a pretty head and friendly eye, a good neck and shoulder. A deep body with a short pointed croup. Adequate bone but the knees not prominent enough and front pasterns a bit steep. Long energetic walk using the back well. Good rhythm at trot, but moves a bit close behind.



CARESS (*OMAN x CSILLA) 1990 mare

157 (15.2)-195-18.5 8,7,8,7,6,7

A rather big mare of good type with a rather short but sufficient neck. Good body, but the hindquarters a bit short and steep. Well-developed gaskins, good angles in fetlocks and hocks. Very narrow in walk and trot.





BARON AF (*OMAN x *BIALA) 1989 stallion
 Breeder: Adele Furby, Owner: Bev Grimes
 156 (15.1+)-0193-19.7 7,7,7,5,6,8
 A compact, masculine stallion with a very good head and eye set on a slightly short neck with good topline. Powerful body but the back a bit soft. Good legs and good leg angles. Moving too close in front at walk. Strong trot but moving on three tracks.



SHAGYA SCHERZO AF (*SHANDOR x *AMINAH) 1991 stallion
 Breeder: Adele Furby, Owner: Paul and Marty Morgan
 154 (15.1) 189-19.0 8,8,6,6,5,7,8
 A typey Shagya stallion with a masculine head. A deep body, but with a long loin and a bit short hindquarter. Flat bone, toed out off-fore and a bit overangulated behind. Good walk and long trot.



SURANY (SHAGYA XLII-1 x BINT BINT GHASALA) 1991 mare (Part-Shagya-Arabian)
 Bred and owned by Darlene Steven
 147 (14.2)-170-18.0 6,8,7,6,7,8
 A very small mare with a refined head and neck. Good shoulder and good depth of body. Very fine bone in front and small knees. Ordinary walk, good gallop and free trot.



SHAGYA SUN AF (*SHANDOR x *AMINAH) 1990 stallion
 Breeder: Adele Furby, Owner: Gwynn Davis
 157 (15.2)-188-19.8 8,7,-,8,9,8
 A Shagya stallion of good type with a masculine Shagya head set on a well-shaped but rather short neck. Good withers. Impressive use of back considering spinal fracture. Good flat bone and well-defined joints. Long swinging walk and good trot.



***GHASARA (HALADIN ox x GHAZALA) 1977 mare**
 Breeder: Hans and Leni Walter, Owner: Darlene Steven
 152 (15.0)-183-18.0 8,7,7,6,7,8
 A nice older mare showing Shagya and purebred Arabian points. A Shagya head set on a long neck which has a convex underline. Good depth and width. Nice flat bone but a bit fine. Free rhythmic trot.



SONATA PFF (*SHANDOR x SJONJA) 1992 mare
 Bred and owned by Nancy Skakel
 158 (15.2+)-180-18.5 9,8,8,7,8,9
 A big, scopey mare of good Shagya type shown in an underweight condition. Good Shagya head and good length of rein. Good saddle area. Good angles in fetlocks and hocks. Excellent movements and use of the back.



BAYRAM (*OMAN x *BIALA) 1991 stallion
 Breeder: Adele Furby, Owner: Daunna Sellers and Elisha Willie
 155 (15.1)-187-18.2 8,8,7,6,5,6,7
 A very pleasing young stallion with good long lines. Nice head and long elegant neck. Smooth, balanced body (damaged off fore knee). Legs with fine bone. Moving base narrow at walk, better at trot.



BLUE VELVET (*BUDAPEST x BLUE RAFONEKA ox) 1990 mare (Part-Shagya-Arabian)
 149 (14.3)-192-18.2 7,7,8,7,7,7
 A small mare showing Shagya influence. Nice eye, but the head a bit convex. Rounded body with undefined withers. Good length of pelvis. Good legs, toes out a bit. Ordinary walk and trot and good gallop.



KORÁ (*OMAN x LHF KAASHA ox) 1992 mare (Part-Shagya-Arabian)
 Bred and owned by Gwynn Davis
 148 (14.2+)-172-17.5 7,7,8,7,7,8
 Small but very promising *OMAN daughter with harmonious build. A pleasing, feminine head with a good eye. Good limbs, correct movements, and well-balanced trot.





SA REGAL (*GHAZON x JAYEL TONGAFARAH ox) 1993 gelding (Part-Shagya-Arabian)
Breeder: Daunna Sellers, Owner: Mindy Mink
7,8,8,7,7,8

A nice type riding gelding with a pretty head, a long shoulder with a good saddle area. Toed out and close in hocks. Nice, smooth, elastic trot.



CONDOR (*SHANDOR x RAVENWOOD CRESANT ox) 1991 stallion
Breeder: Adele Furby, Owner: Don and Patti Cook
160 (15.3)-178-19.5 9,9,7,8,7,8

A big, strong young Shagya stallion with lots of presence. A masculine, well-shaped head on a long, well-shaped neck. Big shoulder and good topline. Broad enough, but not enough depth at the moment. Very good prominent foreknees, a little pressed in at elbows. (Fetlocks a bit puffy at moment.) Walk a little short, good trot.



*85 O'BAJAN XIII (O'BAJAN XIII x 174 SHAGYA XXXVI) 1968 mare
Breeder: Babolna Stud, Owner: Don and Patti Cook
152 (15.0)-181-18.5 9,9,8,9,8,9

A classic Shagya mare of the O'Bajan type. Body and legs in extremely good condition for her age. Clean limbs and energetic free movement in walk, trot, and gallop.

an old Babolna mother line, was very small and will of course have something to give away of, but it will take longer time, I suppose. KORA (*OMAN x LHF KAASHA ox) was also small, but very harmonious, with good parts for a broodmare. The

daughter BLUE VELVET (x BLUE RAFONIKA ox)

was a very round little mare, showing

Shagya influence. She was in a very "rich" condition and could easily give away some to Nancy Skakel's filly SONATA PFF (*SHANDOR x SJONJA), who was a big, scopey Shagya filly. She really had a good length of rein, good saddle area, and good use of the back. When she was turned loose in the paddock she was just great. The breeding was again *SHANDOR x HUNGARIAN BRAVO daughter. SJONJA, the dam, didn't even have a full "7" for her average score—but look what she produced.

Nearly all of you taking part in the learner's seminar had difficulties placing this mare. Mostly because she was thin? It is easier to judge a thin horse than a fat horse! Please, look upon this with more wide eyes for the

Shagya breed in the USA rather than in a personal way—this is the kind of mare which will compete with other breeds, Trakehners, Hannoverians, Danish Warmbloods, and Swedish Warmbloods. All we can do now is to wait for what the next generations

will bring you! It is too early to say anything else other than that YOU ARE ON THE RIGHT TRACK!

A very promising part-Shagya gelding, SA REGAL (GHAZON x JAYEL TONGAFARA ox) was also shown, and then we were on our way to Ohio to see the last three horses.

The first Shagya we met was stabled at a very fantastic purebred Arabian place. That was ORANA SHAGYA, born in 1983, by the purebred Arabian stallion ORANAGAH and out of the imported *89 SHAGYA XL, and apart from her very cresty neck she was a pleasing Shagya mare. The next mare we saw was to me THE QUEEN OF AMERICA—*85 O'BAJAN XIII out of 174 SHAGYA XXXVI. Just think that you still can be judging a daughter from the "black jewel" of Babola! And in her age (26) she just wouldn't stop moving in an excellent trot and a beautiful gallop.



ORANA SHAGYA (ORANAGAH ox x *89 SHAGYA XL) 1983 mare
Breeder: Jean Bishop, Owner: Don and Patti Cook
154 (15.1)-181-18.2 8,7,7,7,7,8

A pleasing Shagya mare with a good Shagya head and calm appearance and friendly eye. A well set on cresty neck with a dip in front of the wither. A good saddle area, smooth loins, and croup a bit flat. Good shoulder, dry bone. Free walk and light, easy trot moving very close behind.
