### **RESPONSIVE READING-Isaiah 58: 1-5**

"Cry aloud, do not hold back! Raise your voice like a ram's horn. Declare to My people their transgression. And to the house of Jacob their sins.

For day after day, they seek me and delight to know my ways, like a nation that does what is right and does not forsake the justice of their God. They ask me for righteous judgments; they delight in the nearness of God."

"Why have we fasted, and You have not seen? Why have we humbled ourselves, and you have not noticed?" "Behold, on the day of your fast, you do as you please and oppress your workers. You fast with contention and strife to strike viciously with your fist. You cannot fast as you do today and have your voice be heard on high.


#### UNISON READING- Isaiah 58:6-7


