The Men's Cross Country team concluded an epic season last weekend as the first team in 5 seasons qualifying to run at the State meet at National Trail Raceway in Hebron, OH. The team was one of 20 teams in D1 (of 199) to qualify. While they finished 20th, the goal of making it to state for the senior class was the real goal. Leading up to the State meet was a victory in the ECC Championship where freshman Alex Justus finished second and fellow frosh Caleb Chunn finished 8th, both earning 1st team conference status. The following week, the men finished 2nd in the district race at VOA. Senior Gideon Diebel and Nate Muenchen paced the team with 7th and 10th place honors, respectively. Two weeks ago, at the SW regional in Troy the guys earned their state qualification with a 5th place showing. The top 5 Knight runners were all under 17:15 on a very wet & muddy course, including senior Noah Stubenrauch and junior Jacob Krynock. Finally, senior Isaac Onnen signed during the fall signing period to run for Tiffin University next year. Despite losing 13 seniors from this year's team, the returning members have times that should put them back in the mix for a return to the State meet next year.
