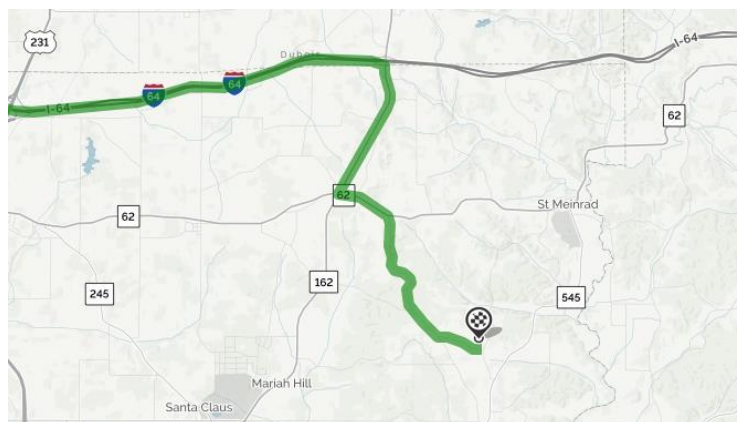
Directions to:

- Turn right onto N Fruda Shortcut RD for about 2.5 miles to E County Road 1740.
- Turn left onto E County Road 1740 for about ¾ mile
