CARRIAGE HOUSE FARM Red Pine Hunter-Jumper Horse Show

May 11th & 12th, 2024

RPHSA is excited for the first show of the 2024 RPHSA season at Carriage House Farm in Hugo, MN. Address of farm is 17727 Henna Avenue North, Hugo, MN 55038.

Here are a few important things to know.

VACCINATIONS & COGGINS: All horses visiting the farm are required to have a negative Coggins within the past 12 months and flu/rhino vaccination within the past 6 months (but not less than 2 wks before show date). You <u>must</u> bring a <u>copy</u> of both records to the show office before unloading your horse.

ENTRIES close May 4th, or before, if full. Late entries will be accepted if space allows.

Arrival- please do not arrive on the farm before 6:00am each show day.

STABLING-

PLEASE DO NOT ARRIVE ON SHOWGROUNDS BEFORE 12PM FRIDAY, MAY 10th (Owner John appreciates you complying with this request!)

IMPORTANT If you need a stall, you must email or text Missy 763-350-9237 to reserve. You will <u>not</u> have a stall if you reserve one at Horsehowsonline but do not contact Missy. Any riders with a stall must register at www.horseshowsonline.com within 1 week of reserving stall in order to keep reservation.

Cost of stabling per day is \$65/day. Weekend stall is \$130. Single overnight is additional \$20; horses cannot arrive before Friday at 12pm. Tack stalls will only be available after stabling requests are fulfilled. Shavings available \$10/bag. Exhibitors can bring their own shavings, but you must use bedding. Show mgmt. will be inspecting stalls and assessing \$30 stall fee if stall has insufficient shavings.

SHOW RINGS & SCHEDULE

Full schedule is available at HorseShowsOnline.com.

FRIDAY SCHOOLING is available from 1-7pm.

SAT/SUN SCHOOLING is available from 6:30am until 30 min prior to classes starting in each ring.

Three show arenas: (1) Grass Ring, (2) Sand Ring and (3) Indoor Ring

SATURDAY:

Walk-trot and all crossrails will be held in Indoor Arena. Sand Ring will be host all 2'0 classes. All 2'3 to 3 ft classes will be held in Grass Ring.

For crossrail divisions, a rider is able to enter both warm-up crossrail classes. However, show management reserves the right to limit riders to only 1 crossrail class if there are time or weather constraints.

Management reserves the right to cancel classes or move classes to a different arena.

SUNDAY:

Hunter/medal classes will be held in Grass Ring. Jumper classes will be held in Sand Ring.

SHOW MGMT RESERVES RIGHT TO REFUSE ENTRY AND ADJUST SCHEDULE AS NEEDED AND BASED ON ENTRIES

Schooling should be available each morning before show-rings open at 6:30am; rings close 30 min before classes begin in each ring. Schooling during show will be available in designated arena---see Farm map.

NO LUNGING IN SHOW OR SCHOOLING ARENAS. Please use designated lunging area---see Farm map.

CLASSES

HTAP- If you are showing an eligible Thoroughbred in 2'3-2'6 hunters (Class 81 or 91) or 0.85m Schooling Jumpers (Class 181), you must sign up for the companion HTAP class in order to be eligible for prize money. Horseshowsonline is Hunters=Class 500SAT and Jumpers=Class 501. More info can be found at http://www.rphsa.com/htap.html

Stake classes- Riders must enter one, non-stake class at the same height in order to be eligible for a stake class.

Professionals are not eligible to show in Equitation, Medal classes or Adult Jumper classes.

The same horse/rider combination can only enter ONE Derby class. A horse can be ridden at a different height with a different rider, OR a rider can show a different horse at same and/or different height.

There is a two-minute empty gate rule in effect. After two minutes, class will close.

FEES

Method of payments include: Credit card (3.5% fee), cash or check.

When you complete your online entries at horseshowsonline.com, your credit card will hold your reservation but will not be charged until the weekend of the horse show. Cancellation or no-show will incur a \$25 non-refundable office fee, not including any reserved stabling charges. The credit card on file will be charged unless other arrangements are made with show secretary.

Stall fees- see STABLING section above. Shavings \$10/bag. Limited hay is available, \$10/bale.

Office fee- \$30 per horse; late entry fee is \$40 per horse.

Friday schooling per horse \$30 from 1-7pm.

Classes- \$30 per hunter/equitation class; \$40 per jumper class; specialty classes vary and cost will be posted at www.horseshowsonline.com

Add Scratch fees: After 8am on day of Show \$10 per change; day before show-no charge

RPHSA non-member fee \$8 per rider

Fee for a non-showing horse is \$75 per show day if not entered in 2 or more classes each day.

Returned checks /other non-negotiable payment = \$50 fee charged

MISCELLANEOUS

Twin Cities PITA (food vendor) will be available onsite Saturday and Sunday.

No camping onsite without permission from show management; must have a generator. No electrical hook-ups available.

REFUNDS:

Stabling: No refunds for stabling fees 2 weeks prior to start of show---no exceptions. If you reserved a stall and cancel within 2 weeks of show, you will be charged. However, show management will make every effort to sell your stall/bedding to next person on waiting list. If sold, then you will not be charged.

GENERAL RULES & SPECIFICATIONS

RPHSA follows the rules and practices as set forth by the United States Equestrian Federation. It is suggested you have access and familiarity with the USEF rulebook. In the event of a protest or discrepancy, it is recommended that the RPHSA representative(s) at the show make a ruling. This is to be first the secretary, then the show manager.

Management reserves the right to change scheduled class locations or start times for any reason, inclement weather, time constraints or any other reason management decides is best for horse and rider well-being and competition. Stabling and entry refunds resulting from the cancellation/rescheduling of classes due to extreme weather or an act of God, may be given only at the sole discretion of show management.

Horse welfare concerns are to be immediately disclosed to the horse show secretary. Horses entered in the show are limited to either 2 hunter divisions per day (maximum 5 h/j over fences per day). Jumper classes are limited to 4 classes per day per horse at .75m or lower and limited to 3 jumper classes per day per horse at .85m or higher.
