On March 18th, DGK Mark Sobol and I attended the Ultrasound Machine presentation at the Pregnancy Service Center of Greater Lansing, which is located on the campus of MSU. What a wonderful day for everyone who was there. This ultrasound machine was result of our "Ultrasound Initiative" fundraiser we had back in November. I am honored to say that Council #1266 raised the most money for this project with nearly \$6000 of the \$17237 needed. The K of C councils of the Archdiocese of Detroit South and the Supreme Council each contributed \$17237 to purchase this machine along with a 46" flat screen television. At the time of the presentation, this new 3D ultrasound machine had saved eight babies as confirmed by the Pregnancy Center director Nancy Kujawa. Thanks to everyone that made this possible. This machine was the 46th ultrasound machine donated in the state of Michigan by the Knights of Columbus.
