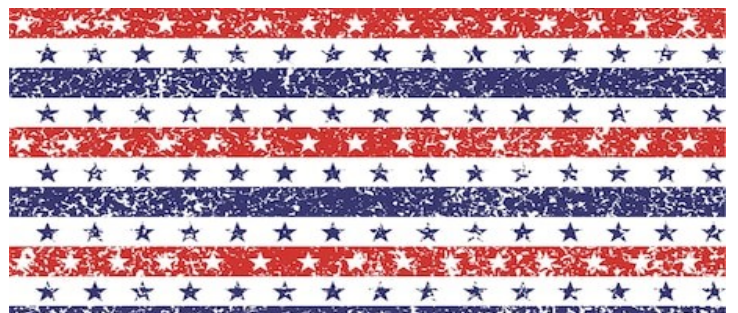
## RETURN TO SCHOOL SURVEY
