Johnny's Seeds Artisan - Pink Bumblebee Tomato	annual	artisan-style / open-pollinated	Pink, round cherry tomatoes are striped with yellow and orange.

Tomato, bite-size, Black cherry tomato	annual	open pollinated / heirloom	A dark purplish brownish cherry - quite large and quite prolific. And super sweet! This is the one I grow late in the season as my sole fresh tomato in the greenhouse. Sweet and robust. Bred in Florida by the late Vince Sapp, the round, 15–20 gm. fruits are almost black in color. The flavor is dynamic — much like an heirloom. High yielding. Indeterminate.

Tomato, bite-size, Grape Tomato	annual	f1	Sweetest grape tomato, bred by Johnny's. Five Star Grape has excellent, sweet flavor and firm, meaty texture with few seeds and little juice. Healthy plants bear high yields of bright red, 15-20 gm, crack resistant grape tomatoes. Indeterminate.
Tomato, bite-size, Jaune Flamme	annual	open- pollinated / heirloom	These are tasty bright golden orange cocktail sized (larger than the typical cherry-sized) tomatoes. (aka Flamme) Beautiful tomato that originated with Norbert Perreira of Helliner, France. Commercialized by Tomato Growers Supply Company in 1997. Early crops of apricot-colored 4 ounce fruits borne on elongated trusses. Excellent fruity flavor with a perfect blend of sweet and tart. Great for drying or roasting, retains deep orange color. Indeterminate,
Tomato, bite-size, matt's wild cherry	annual	open pollinated / heirloom	This vine is crazy-prolific and just filled with very small but very sweet red cherry tomatoes.
Tomato, bite-size, Red Pear or Red Fig	annual	open pollinated / heirloom	Small pear shaped red tomatoes. This is an heirloom from Italy which I am hoping has better flavor than the previous red pears I've tried.
Tomato, bite-size, Sun Gold	annual	f1	High in antioxidants and delicious ziggy flavor. Intense fruity flavor. Exceptionally sweet, bright tangerine-orange cherry tomatoes leave everyone begging for more. Vigorous plants start yielding early and bear right through the season. Tendency to split precludes shipping, making these an exclusively fresh-market treat. The taste can't be beat. 15-20 gm. fruits. High resistance to fusarium wilt and tobacco mosaic virus. Indeterminate.

Tomato, bite-size, Super Sweet 100's	annual	f1	This is the cherry tomato I grew up with. A very nice and dependable red cherry. The classic sweet, red cherry tomato. Supersweet 100 is a reliable cherry tomato with prolific yields of great tasting, 15-20 gm. fruits produced in large clusters. Widely adapted. High resistance to fusarium wilt and verticillium wilt. Indeterminate.
Tomato, bite-size, Tomato Berry Garden	annual	f1	Cocktail-sized strawberry-shaped red tomatoes - Unique strawberry-shaped fruits. High-yielding plants. Deep red fruits have broad shoulders which taper to a blunt point at the blossom end, giving them a heart-like appearance. Firm, meaty texture with excellent sweet flavor. Fruits avg. 1" x 1" and weigh approximately 10-15 gm. Indeterminate.

Adelaide Festival	annual	open pollinated	'Adelaide Festival' is a vigorous, rugose, regular leaf variety that produces fruits that are a rich purple color (clear skinned black) with green stripes that ripen to olive-gold. They are medium-sized (six to ten ounce), smooth, oblate in shape, very juicy and tender with a delicious, well-balanced flavor that is neither too tart or too sweet. Developed by members of the "Dwarf Tomato Project" from a cross between 'Rosella Purple' and 'Pink Berkeley Tie Dye'. It was selected and named by Patrina Nuske Small of Australia in appreciation of the Adelaide Festival of Arts fireworks.

Blazing Beauty	annual	open pollinated	A new 2019 Dwarf tomato to try - regular sized tomatoes on a squatty and compact plant. Perfect for small spaces and dependable vigor. Dwarf Blazing Beauty' was the first orange variety released by the "Dwarf Tomato Project." Its plants are vigorous with rugose, potato leaves. The fruits are medium to medium large (four to fourteen ounces), smooth oblate and a deep orange color in and out. The flavor sparkles with an ample tart bite and is quite intense, very much resembling one of its parents, 'Elbe'.
Caitydid	annual	open pollinated	A new 2019 Dwarf tomato to try - regular sized tomatoes on a squatty and compact plant. Perfect for small spaces and dependable vigor. Smooth, oblate, yellow with red swirls. The flavor is well balanced and delicious. Dwarf Caitydid' is a rugose, regular leaf variety that produces lots of medium to large, smooth, oblate-shaped, yellow tomatoes with red swirls, and heavy red coloration in the flesh. The flavor is well balanced and delicious. Developed by members of the "Dwarf Tomato Project" from a cross between 'New Big Dwarf' and 'Mortgage Lifter' (Pesta Strain) made by Patrina Nuske Small in 2007 and named "Pesty." 'Dwarf Caitydid' was selected and named by Craig LeHoullier after his daughter, Caitlin, in 2011.

<p>Crimson Sockeye</p>	<p>annual</p>	<p>open pollinated</p>	<p>Dwarf Crimson Sockeye' is a rugose, regular leaf variety that produces large yields of medium (four to ten ounce) tomatoes. The fruits are smooth-skinned with slightly-ribbed shoulders, oblate in shape, with a well-balanced flavor.</p> <p>As their name implies, the underlying color is that of a pink fruit but like pink fruits in the black-fruited category, they retain varying degrees of chlorophyll giving them a richer, darker pink exterior color made obvious when slicing them open. And although this variety has appeared quite stable and consistent for us, we have seen other vendors offering 'Dwarf Crimson Sockeye' that appears to be a throwback to it's 'Rosella Purple' parentage.</p> <p>Developed by members of the "Dwarf Tomato Project" this variety originated from a cross between 'Rosella Purple' and 'Pink Berkeley Tie Dye.' 'Dwarf Crimson Sockeye' was first bred by Patrina Nuske Small in 2009 and named "Tidy." It was then developed, selected, and named by Ted Maiden with Sue Bailey. It was introduced for the 2016 gardening season.</p>
<p>Emerald Giant</p>	<p>annual</p>	<p>open pollinated</p>	<p>A new 2019 Dwarf tomato to try - regular sized tomatoes on a squatty and compact plant. Perfect for small spaces and dependable vigor. Essentially a dwarfed version of 'Green Giant'.</p>

Maralinga	annual	open pollinated	<p>A new 2019 Dwarf tomato to try - regular sized tomatoes on a squatty and compact plant. Perfect for small spaces and dependable vigor. The flavor is rich, intense and memorable. The rugose, regular leaf plants produce heavy yields of rich-brown (yellow skinned black) tomatoes with deep crimson flesh that range between six to twelve ounces. The flavor shares the typical intensity of the best black tomatoes; rich, intense and memorable.</p> <p>'Maralinga' is a "Dwarf Tomato Project" variety that originated with a cross between an early generation selection from the "Sleepy family" called 'Wilpena' and 'Cherokee Purple' made by Patrina Nuske Small in 2008 and named "Plentiful."</p>
Numbat	annual	open pollinated	<p>Dwarf Numbat' produces medium small, three ounce, round shaped tomatoes resemble the parent 'Green Zebra', being striped with green and gold on the outside, and green, tart, tasty flesh. Its rugose, regular leaf plants are very prolific.</p>
Peppermint Stripe	annual	open pollinated	<p>A new 2019 Dwarf tomato to try - regular sized tomatoes on a squatty and compact plant. Perfect for small spaces and dependable vigor. Oblate, green with light and dark green and pink striped skin, green with pink marbling, 8-12 oz., delicious slicer.</p>
Purple Heart	annual	open pollinated	<p>A new 2019 Dwarf tomato to try - regular sized tomatoes on a squatty and compact plant. Perfect for small spaces and dependable vigor. Productive, medium to large sized (6-16 oz.) heart shaped purple tomatoes. The vigorous, rugose, regular leaf plants are among the most spreading and branching of the dwarf varieties. Producing heavy yields of medium to medium large sized (six to sixteen ounce) heart shaped purple tomatoes.</p> <p>'Dwarf Purple Heart' has deep crimson flesh with a delicious, well-balanced flavor. Although fairly large, the fruits also ripen relatively early.</p>

Saucy Mary			The rugose, regular leaf plants of 'Dwarf Saucy Mary' produce loads of four to six ounce, elongated fruits that have green skin, with dark and light green stripes, and that are green-fleshed when ripe. They are juicy and very flavorful.
Sleeping Lady	annual	open pollinated	This was a huge hit last year in 2018. Prolific producer even in slight shade and very rainy conditions. Tomatoes are compact with tight flesh and great flavor. The plants themselves are short and stocky and do great in containers and on small patio spaces.

Tomato, medium, Amish Paste	annual	open- pollinated / heirloom	This is a wonderfully tasty pointy ended red plum. Great for sauce. A long-time favorite heirloom plum. Large for a sauce tomato, Amish Paste's slightly irregular plum-to strawberry shaped fruits avg. 8-12 oz. with excellent flavor. These meaty tomatoes are good in salads and great for processing. A Slow Food USA Ark of Taste variety. Indeterminate.
Tomato, Paste/Sauce, Anna Banana Russian Tomato	annual	open- pollinated / heirloom	New 2019 A bright yellow to orange version of 'Anna Russian'. The fruits are heart-shaped, weigh up to thirteen ounces, and are delicious tasting. They often have a slight pink blush on the inside.
Tomato, Paste/Sauce, Black Icicle	annual	open pollinated / heirloom	A black plum with a pointy end.
Tomato, medium, Black Mauri	annual	open pollinated / heirloom	A black plum tomato - sweet with purple skin.

Tomato, medium, Black Pear	annual	open pollinated / heirloom	Larger than the yellow and red salad pear or fig tomatoes, with the bright and sweet flavor typical of black tomatoes.
Tomato, medium, Black Plum	annual	open pollinated / heirloom	Another black plum - I really want to do a taste test this summer and compare flavors.
Tomato, medium, Black Zebra	annual	open pollinated / heirloom	Mostly red with green and yellow stripes - these are in the same style as the Green Zebra. Absolutely gorgeous.
Tomato, medium, Blue Beech	annual	open pollinated	High-yielding heirloom paste tomato. This "sausage" type paste tomato produces large, 8–10 oz., elongated fruits that are easy to process into sauce. An excellent canning tomato, it also tastes great when eaten fresh. Attractive green shoulders give a distinct heirloom look. Fruits ripen during a concentrated period, allowing for a more efficient canning process. It is well-adapted to northern climates, and resists disease and blossom end rot better than others of its type. This strain of Blue Beech was originally brought to Vermont from Italy during WWII. Indeterminate.
Tomato, medium, Bloody Butcher	annual	open pollinated / heirloom	A sensational, multi-purpose tomato, very early and high-yielding. Strong tomato flavor in medium, round, 4 oz. fruits that are a deep, dark red inside and out. Potato-leaved plants are fast growing.
Tomato, medium, Chili Verde	annual	open pollinated / heirloom	New 2019 - a long pointy bottomed paste in a green color with a taste like a sweet tomatillo
Tomato, medium, Fourth of July	annual	f1	A very dependable very early tomato with great flavor and loads of fruits.

Tomato, medium, Garden Peach	annual	open pollinated / heirloom	Open-pollinated. For well over a century savvy gardeners have brought Peach's little fruits indoors before frost to keep for several weeks. 2 oz yellow fruits blush pink when ripe and have thin fuzzy skins somewhat like peaches. Relatively early, prolific, soft-skinned, juicy and very sweet. Light fruity taste is not what you'd expect in a tomato. Burpee in 1893 called it "delicate, melting in the mouth like a grape." Amy Goldman places its 1890 origins with plant breeder Elbert S. Carman, owner and editor of The Rural New-Yorker. It was introduced as a novelty in Hallock & Son's (of Queens) 1890 catalog.
Tomato, medium, Glacier	annual	open pollinated / heirloom	A relatively cold hardy early tomato - determinate vines. Quite sweet for an ultra-early. Coloring is slightly orange. Delicious first-early heirloom. Cocktail sized, 1-2 oz. red fruits borne on a compact, determinate plant. Sweetness combines with moderate acidity to create a wonderfully complex flavor. Smooth internal texture characteristic of the finer heirlooms. Very nice eating tomato. Tolerant of cooler spring temperatures and particularly well-adapted to the North. Generally the first tomato to ripen in the field. Watering evenly will reduce splitting. Determinate.
Tomato, medium, Golden King of Siberia	annual	open pollinated / heirloom	This tomato is one of the real favorites here. Big, lemon-yellow fruit are a delightful heart shape. The flesh is smooth, creamy and has a nicely balanced sweet taste. I always find myself "snacking" on these beauties. Plants are very productive and seem to have some disease resistance.
Tomato, medium, Green Zebra	annual	open- pollinated / heirloom	A delicious tomato that is ripe when green. These little beauties are mostly light green with darker green stripes. A delicious, tangy salad tomato, ripe just as the green fruit develops a yellow blush, accentuating the darker green stripes. The 3-4 oz. fruits are the ideal size for slicing into wedges for salads. Productive over a long season. Developed by Tom Wagner. Indeterminate.

Tomato, Paste/Sauce, Hungarian Heart	annual	open pollinated / heirloom	First listed in the 1991 SSE Yearbook by Jerry Muller of Alabama. He acquired the variety in 1988 from Ed Simon of Pennsylvania. Simon stated it was brought to the United States in 1901 from a village 20 miles from Budapest. Huge pink oxheart fruits weigh upwards of one pound. Very few seeds and almost no cracking. One of our favorites for fresh eating, canning, and for making roasted tomato sauce. Indeterminate
Tomato, medium, Indigo Rose	annual	open pollinated	The darkest tomato I've ever seen - very small and firm true egg-plant purple with green shoulders. The vines are quite purple too. Prolific plant. Unique, dark tomato, exceptionally high in anthocyanins. Anthocyanins are powerful anti-oxidants. In the early stages of fruit development, Indigo Rose develops a dark purple pigment in its skin where exposed to direct sunlight. Green when unripe, purple-red when ripe, the 1-2 oz., cocktail-sized tomatoes have good flavor with 'plummy' overtones. Developed by Jim Myers at Oregon State University using traditional plant breeding techniques. Moderately vigorous. Compact indeterminate.
Tomato, medium, Japanese Black trifele	annual	open- pollinated / heirloom	Unusual pear shape and burgundy color. Good yields of 4-6 oz. fruit with excellent, rich flavor. Harvest when shoulders are still green for best taste. Potato-leaf plants. Indeterminate.
Tomato, medium, Kangaroo Paw Brown	annual	open pollinated / heirloom	New 2019 - Kangaroo Paw Brown' is a later season variety with plants that are vigorous, prolific, uniform, compact dwarf in habit with rugose, regular leaf foliage. The fruits are round to flattened-globe in shape, two to six ounces in weight, and have deep crimson flesh and dark, chocolate colored shoulders when ripe. Very tasty.

Tomato, Paste/Sauce, King Humbert (Roi Umberto) Tomato	annual	open pollinated / heirloom	New 2019 - a roma shape, small, with a yellow splash ... The regular-leaf plants of 'King Humbert' are productive and vigorous, but fairly compact for an indeterminate variety. Its fruits are a blocky, elongated plum-shaped, red colored, two to three ounce, paste-type tomatoes borne in clusters. They are meaty but are pleasantly juicy and deliver an interesting, slightly sweet, mild flavor. They are good for drying or sauces, yet quite suitable for fresh eating. It does well both in the ground as it does in a greenhouse.
Tomato, Mountain Magic F1 (cocktail sized, blight resistant)	annual	f1	"Excellent flavor and late blight resistant. Mountain Magic produces high yields of 2 oz., bright red, round salad tomatoes with very sweet flavor. Intermediate resistance to early blight. Indeterminate."
Tomato, medium, New Girl Tomato	annual	f1	A great and dependable hybrid. First early, great taste. Fruits avg. 4-6 oz. and are better tasting and more disease resistant than other 'girl' hybrids. Widely adapted. Indeterminate. First early, great flavor.
Tomato, medium, Noire de Crimée (Crimean Black)	annual	open pollinated / heirloom	New for 2019 - a juicy and very sweet cocktail style tomato in a dark brown-purple color. Like a big Black Cherry Tomato.
Tomato, Paste/Sauce, Opalka	annual	open pollinated / heirloom	Red fruits grow to 3 inches by 6 inches Excellent flavor and few seeds Perfect processing tomato Fruits hold well on the vine Indeterminate - Fruit ripens throughout the season
Tomato, Orange Blossom f1	annual	f1	A tasty early orange tomato. The medium-firm, globe-shaped fruits average 6-7 oz., have a nice texture, and are mildly flavored, balanced with a little acidity. Developed by Dr. Brent Loy, Univ. of New Hampshire. Determinate.

Tomato, Oregon Spring	annual	open pollinated	Medium-sized, early, cold tolerant. Avg. 6-7 oz. fruit. First early harvest for cool northern or high-elevation locations. Compact plant. Determinate.
Tomato, medium, Raspberry Lyanna	annual	open pollinated / heirloom	Simply stunning, raspberry-pink fruits are of medium size. Firm flesh is very sweet and richly flavored. This variety from Russia is perfect looking, one of the prettiest tomatoes we have grown. It is almost free of imperfections, making it perfect for marketing.
Tomato, Paste/Sauce, Principe Borghese	annual	open pollinated / heirloom	The perfect tomato for making paste and for sun drying. Fruits grow to 1-2 ounces Red, plum-shaped fruits Well suited for drying Fruit ripens over a 2 week period Bushy plants need support due to the heavy yields Determinate - Fruit ripens over a 2 week period
Tomato, Paste/Sauce, Roma	annual	open pollinated / heirloom	We've been growing this variety of red plum tomato and making great sauces from them for years and years
Tomato, Paste/Sauce, Roman Candle	annual	open pollinated / heirloom	shaped like a san marzano, but yellow

Tomato, medium, Rosso Sicilian Tomato	annual	open pollinated / heirloom	This is a pretty big tomato - Bright red ribbed fruits weigh up to 6 ounces. Firm flesh is perfect for making tomato sauce or paste. Handle carefully - they bruise easily. Determinate - Fruit ripens over a 2 week period(aka Russo Sicilian Togetta) Introduced to SSE by Ann Fuller of Indiana. She received the seed from a man who brought it to the U.S. in 1987 from Sicily where his family had grown it many years. Anne said its slices look like red-petaled flowers (rosso means "red"). Striking crayfish red costoluta (ribbed) fruits weigh up to 6 ounces.
Tomato, medium, Violet Jasper or Tzi Bi U	annual	open pollinated / heirloom	When these little Oriental jewels ripen, your eyes will be stunned with color. They have pretty violet-purple fruit with iridescent green streaks! Fruit weigh 1-3 ounces, are smooth and have good tasting, dark purplish-red flesh. This variety will also amaze you with its yield: it's not only high, but incredibly high, being one of the most productive tomatoes we have grown. A great variety for marketing. Introduced to you from China along with its twin sister "Topaz"
Tomato, Paste/Sauce, San Marzano	annual	open pollinated / heirloom	Some consider this the pinnacle of sauce tomatoes... an heirloom and a classic tomato flavor that all others are judged by...
Tomato, medium, Silvery Fir Tree Tomato	annual	open pollinated / heirloom	Determinate. Heirloom. Think red ornaments hanging from a fir tree and you'll understand how this 2" Russian tomato got its name. The tomato ornaments put on a show when they all ripen at once. Early ripening works with short growing seasons or impatient canners.
Tomato, Paste/Sauce, Speckled Roman	annual	open pollinated / heirloom	Red with yellow stripes - A classic pointy bottomed sauce tomato - a little smaller than San Marzano - great tangy flavor.
Tomato, paste/sauce, Ten Fingers of Naples	annual	open pollinated / heirloom	A prolific producer of lots of long small paste style tomatoes - a classic in naples cooking

Tomato, medium, Tigerella or Red Zebra	annual	open pollinated / heirloom	A mostly red cocktail sized tomato but with an abundance of yellow streaks.
Tomato, Paste/Sauce, Ukrainian Purple Plum	annual	open pollinated	(aka Purple Russian) Original stock of this variety came from Irma Henkel in Ukraine. Plum-shaped fruits are 3-4" long and weigh 6 ounces, generally crack-free. Great flavor, sweet and meaty. Plants are very productive. Indeterminate,

Tomato, Large, Ananas Noir (Black Pineapple)	annual	open pollinated / heirloom	I think this may be my favorite big tomato - Fabulou sziggy tomato flavor, green flesh with stripes and speckled in reds and yellows. A great salad tomato with bitter greens like arugula and chicory.
Tomato, Large, Australian Giant Oxheart	annual	open pollinated / heirloom	New 2019 - The delicious fruits of these large, wispy, regular leaf plants are huge (up to twenty ounces), red in color, heart-shaped and possess very few seeds.
Tomato, Large, Beefsteak or Big Beef	annual	f1	Traditional Jersey-Style Beefsteak Slicer. Nice combination of size, taste, and earliness. Still unsurpassed as the top choice for fresh market beefsteak tomatoes. Large, avg. 10-12 oz., mostly blemish-free, globe-shaped red fruit. They have full flavor - among the best - and ripen early for their size. Broad disease resistance package. High resistance to alternaria stem canker, fusarium wilt races 1, 2, gray leaf spot, nematodes, tobacco mosaic virus, and verticillium wilt. AAS winner. Indeterminate.
Tomato, Large, Big Rainbow	annual	open pollinated / heirloom	Heirloom, bicolored beefsteak tomato weighs 2 lbs. and more. Ripe fruit has light yellow shoulders atop a golden-orange tomato with ruby red radiating from the blossom end. Some red streaks appear through the meaty flesh. A beautiful variety that also has good, sweet flavor. Indeterminate.

Tomato, large, Black Krim	annual	open-pollinated / heirloom	One of my favorite tasting tomatoes. We've been growing these for over ten years and wouldn't grow tomatoes without them! Russian heirloom. Black Krim combines bold, smoky flavor and good texture with an unusual appearance. Deep brown/red, 8-16 oz. tomatoes have brown/green shoulders that get darker with more heat and sunlight. High yielding. Indeterminate. Organically grown.
Tomato, large, Black from Tula	annual	open-pollinated / heirloom	Russian variety imported by SSE from seedswoman Marina Danilenko. First listed in the 1996 SSE Yearbook. Described by one SSE member as "the ugliest, most delicious tomato I've ever grown." Good yields of brownish-red slightly flattened globes weighing up to 14 ounces. Rich full flavor, great for slicing and canning. Indeterminate,
Tomato, Large, Black Seaman	annual	open pollinated / heirloom	A big favorite of mine - gorgeous dark tomatoes with green shoulders. Super Sweet yet firm and bright flavor.
Tomato, Large, Box Car Willie	annual	open pollinated / heirloom	We predict this old-timer might become your main crop variety, due to its prolific yields of smooth, reddish-orange fruits averaging a large 10 to 16 oz.! With an old-fashioned flavor you'll remember from childhood, these high-yielding, multi-use tomatoes will last throughout the season and are ideal for canning, freezing, or for home-cooked meals. Crack-free and disease resistant.
Tomato, Large, Brandywine, Red	annual	open-pollinated / heirloom	Pure bright red but with the very squatty heart-like shape traditional to Brandywine tomatoes. Potato-leaf style. One of the best tasting tomatoes. We describe Brandywine's luscious, heirloom flavor as "very rich, loud, and distinctively spicy."
