GENERAL INFORMATION:

This will be a CLOSED state shoot. Only Alabama residents are eligible to compete.

This shoot will be conducted according to NSSA & ASSA rules.

To be eligible, shooters must be in good standing with the NSSA and present their card when registering.

The shooter is responsible for entering the proper class and desired concurrent(s).

NSSA renewals are available at time of registration. Complementary NSSA membership for First Time Shooters Management reserves the right to refuse entry or cause the withdrawal of any shooter who annoys, endangers, or interferes in any way with the harmony of this shoot.

Risks of theft or accident are assumed by individuals present on the grounds.

Picking up of hulls during the shoot is prohibited.

All orange White Flyer targets will be used including under the lights.

Referees decisions on questions of fact will be final.

Protests made IAW NSSA Rules will be referred to the protest committee.

All score sheets must be signed by a member of the squad prior to leaving the field.

All place ties will be shot off using doubles at stations 3, 4, & 5, miss and out by station. For team shoot offs, total team score by station. Shoot offs will be held under the lights if required.

Ties for all concurrent awards will be shot off **INDEPENDENTLY**.

Shoot off targets provided by ASSA. Shells provided by the shooter.

Champion, Runner-Up, and Third will be removed from class (Prize money remains with shooter). All team events will be classified as Class I.

Five person club team eligibility will be determined by home club designation (or known club membership).

Proof shells will be provided!

In order to keep the costs of the Championship shoot low:

- There will be NO Shoot Tee Shirts provided.
- The Banquet dinner will be provided for each registered shooter & spouse. Additional visitor(s)/guest(s) meals will be available @ \$10 per Banquet meal.
- Triple A class requires a minimum of 5 entries
