WORTHY CHAPLAIN



My Eagle Brothers and Sisters, I pray all of you are well and enjoying the Spring season. May is an important month to us all, first, we celebrate Mother's Day on May 9th. Remember that the Fraternal Order of Eagles were involved in the formation of this special day to

honor our mothers. On May 30th, we celebrate Memorial Day, a special time to honor those military members who bravely served our country and lost their lives serving. I hope you remember that Memorial Day is not just a back yard cook out or a day at the beach or store sale at the mall. I'd like to share a few thoughts with you as this will be my final Chaplain news column as I finish my 2 years as such. A friend once told me that he had decided to re-pot a plant. He found that, when he pulled it from the pot, the entire plant pulled out easily. The roots were tangled and matted together in a dense, tightly woven mass. The plant had become "Root-Bound." He re-potted it and put it on his balcony and forgot all about it ... until one day he was talking to someone on the phone while looking out his sliding glass door at the plant. He confessed: "that phone conversation, added to the image of the plant, led to a confrontation from God. When my friend re-potted the plant on his balcony, he did something to it first: he slashed the root ball repeatedly with a knife. He didn't cut the major roots but broke up the network of secondary ones to encourage them to branch out. That's what God does. He uses situations and circumstances to slash through those things that hinder us from branching. We would normally call these "growing pains". He doesn't put us in a larger pot without some major adjustments to our root system. Paul prays that the Ephesians would be "rooted and grounded in love" and that they "may be able to comprehend with all the saints what is the width and length and depth and height -to know the love of Christ which passes knowledge" (3:17b-19a) Perhaps our love, both for God and for others, has grown "Root Bound" and limited. Maybe God needs to slash open the repetitive cycle so we can branch out from the tiny pot in which we have placed ourselves, and into the infinite soil of Christ's love. May our heavenly father bless and keep all of you in the palm of his hand.

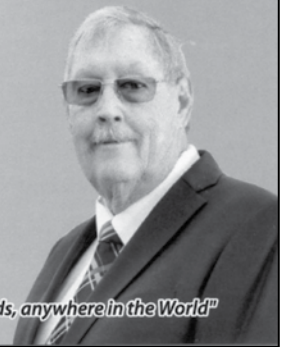
