## **LIFE FROM GOD**

As we approach Holy Week, our Readings speak of a God who, in the midst of death, brings new life to the people. In Ezekiel, we hear that God will open the graves of the people of Israel, who faced near extinction. In the Gospel of John, Jesus gives new life to Lazarus in a manner that prefigures the Resurrection of Jesus. Paul tells the Romans that in Christ, God will not only give life to our bodies after death, but God offers us abundant life here and now. We observe that the external conditions for the people described in these Readings did not radically change. Israel was still in exile. Lazarus would eventually face death again. But now God's presence and power are revealed. Even when our situation in life is difficult and perhaps not likely to change soon, we remember that the Spirit dwells within us.

#### Dear Parishioners,

This weekend (March 25th) we celebrate the Solemnity of the Annunciation of the Blessed Virgin Mary. This day recalls the great event in history, the Incarnation of Our Lord in the womb of the Virgin Mary. On this day the Word was made flesh, and we celebrate Mary's "yes" to the will of God through the announcement of the angel Gabriel. In the words of Benedict XVI: "The icon of the Annunciation, more than any other, helps us to see clearly how everything in the Church goes back to that mystery of Mary's acceptance of the divine Word, by which, through the action of the Holy Spirit, the Covenant between God and humanity was perfectly sealed."

In light of this great feast, I would like to draw our attention to two developments in the parish surrounding images of the Blessed Mother. Firstly, I want to thank one of our parish families for arranging and contributing towards the repair of the fountain at Our Lady's shrine at the entrance of the church. After having been broken for many years, I am happy to see it running and adding beauty to the church! Secondly, an update regarding the lovely statue of Our Lady of Fatima, donated by the Portuguese community earlier this year: I am still considering the final location for the statue, and in the meantime it is being kept safely in the sacristy. We are planning for a special parish celebration for the Feast of Our Lady of Fatima (May 13th) and I hope to have the location determined around that time.

The Most Reverend Robert F. Vasa, Bishop of the Diocese of Santa Rosa, along with the Diocesan and Religious Priests of the Diocese invite you to participate in the Mass of the Chrism at the Cathedral of St. Eugene in Santa Rosa on Thursday, March 30, 2023 at 5:30 p.m.

The Mass of the Chrism is celebrated once a year, during which the Bishop blesses the oil of Catechumens, the oil of the Sick and the oil of Chrism. This Mass is one of the principal expressions of the fullness of the ministerial priesthood that the Bishop has received and it also signifies the unity the Priests have with the Bishop who share in the same ministerial priesthood.

During this Mass the Diocesan and Religious Priests will renew their commitment of priestly service.




#### **ANOINTING OF THE SICK**
