Special Exhibits

Liza Lucy

Liza has been crafting with yarn, fabric, and thread for as long as she can remember, influenced by her mother and grandmother. Growing up in her family's small-town department store, she loved the "remnant" section with its vibrant craft felt, embroidery thread, and cotton fabrics. Liza's quiltmaking journey began in college with a quilt made from 25 bandanas for her boyfriend's waterbed.

After college, she attended graduate school for clinical psychology while working at a high-end needlepoint shop. She eventually left school to work there full-time, later opening her own store. Following its closure, she became a knitting yarn sales rep, representing the new Rowan Yarn Company and forming a close friendship with designer Kaffe Fassett.

Liza and Kaffe collaborated on quiltmaking projects, starting with a book in 1993. Together, they have written five hardcover books and contributed to 15 softcover books, founding the Rowan Patchwork and Quilting Company. They are traditional quiltmakers with a contemporary sense of color and design.

Meg Cox

"Talking to History: Help Your Quilts Tell Their Stories" - Whether it's your grandkids or a museum curator, one day there will be people begging to know more about your quilts when you aren't around to answer questions. This lecture and trunk show will fill you with fresh ideas about how to both label and archive your quilts. Meg Cox has interviewed museum curators, collectors and historians who share the information they most want to see and read on a quilt label. She will show outside-the-box methods for sharing more of your quilt stories in multiple media. You will learn not just how you finish your labels, but how to preserve your quilts' stories in multiple online archives.

Meg Cox's popular newsletter "Quilt Journalist Tells All" has been taking readers behind the scenes of the quilt world since 2008 and she authored a bestselling resource guide called The Quilter's Catalog. She has lectured to hundreds of guilds and groups and written about quilts for publications from Quiltfolk magazine (staff writer since 2018) to The Wall Street Journal. She serves on the board of the International Quilt Museum in Lincoln, NE and is past president of the Quilt Alliance, a nonprofit focused on the oral history of quilts. She has been making quilts since her mother taught her in 1988 and is a proud member of the Manhattan Quilters Guild and Central Jersey Modern Quilt Guild.

Jo Ann Lepore

Hello and welcome to my world. I have been sewing since the age of 8. I took my first sewing class at the age of 9. No need to tell you how long ago that was. In 1985 I started my wholesale decorative accessory company. A line of handcrafted gift items, decorative accessories and upholstered real like children's furniture all made from fine fabrics and manufactured in the USA. For nearly 30 years my lines were sold in retail gift and department stores throughout the world...would you believe it!!

In between all of that I have taught quilt making in New Jersey and the Northeast for 25+ years. Currently I teach projects and techniques that I love and create quilts for competitive entry. I have been fortunate to have been honored with a number of show ribbons highlighting my success and have been published in national quilting magazines. I have had the opportunity to speak at several regional quilt guilds sharing my excitement and passion for the art of quilting.

Over the last several years I have had the opportunity to study with both national and international quilts professionals including Ricky Tims, Mary Mashuta, Sharon Schamber, Kathy Doughty to name a few. In 2023 I accepted a contract with Fox Chapel publications to write a book including 15 of my original quilt designs. Watch for it in late 2024.

There is no doubt that I will continue on this path since quilting is my passion and I can truly say I am addicted to the excitement and reward the art has continually brought me.
