Recycle Reciclar



Paper Newspapers, magazines, mail & envelopes (windows ok), office/scrap paper, cartons. flattened cardboard

Metal Rinsed aluminum, tin, and steel cans, empty aerosol cans, clean aluminum foil, scrap metal

Plastic Rinsed bottles and tubs (6 oz or larger) and buckets (5 gallons and smaller)



NO plastic bags, plastic clamshells, polystyrene, "compostable" serviceware, coffee cups or lids, frozen food boxes or trays, plastic lids, hot or cold drink cups, paper or plastic plates/cups, plastic utensils, take-out containers, or glass (glass should go in the separate red bin).

Garbage Basura



NO electronics, computers, monitors, TVs, hazardous waste, chemicals, medical sharps like needles, fluorescent light bulbs, or batteries. Use WashingtonCountyRecycles.com/WTRW or call 503-846-3605 to find out where to take these items.

Yard Debris

Desechos del jardín



NO "compostable" or "biodegradable" serviceware or containers, yard tools, dirt, rocks, pet waste, or garbage.

Weeds, leaves,

vines, grass clippings, house plants, flowers, branches less than 4 inches in diameter and shorter than 36 inches in length

Glass Vidrio



Glass bottles and jars Put glass into separate red bin. Remove lids. Labels OK. NO vases, drinking

glasses, or lightbulbs.

Motor Oil

Aceite de motor



Motor Oil Put in a leakproof, clear plastic jug with lid and place next to bins.

NO other liquids accepted.

Set out roll carts and bins:

- · At the curb by 6 a.m.
- At least 3 feet from cars, trees and each other.
- · Without blocking sidewalks or bike paths. or driveways

What to recycle and where?

You can recycle some items that don't go into your recycling roll cart by taking them to a dropoff recycling center. Items include batteries, Styrofoam, electronics, medications, paint, plastic bags, shoes and clothing, and more.

Find a location near you by using WashingtonCountyRecycles.com/WTRW or by calling 503-846-3605. Call the facility before you go to confirm hours, items accepted, and if there are fees.



Household hazardous waste and sharps

Household hazardous waste and medical sharps can be disposed of at a Metro drop-off hazardous waste facility or a free neighborhood collection
