100 (ish) YEARS AGO
Board of Village Trustees, Cascade, ID

November 9, 1922 - Mr. L.L. Moore, reported trip to the Lake as to the condition found the pipe filled with rock and dirt by some person unknown.

On motion that Robert Dunn be authorized to shut off the water at the lake and the concrete dam so as to prevent it from overflowing and putting the water out of its natural course.

May 1, 1923 - Mr. W.R. Coleman made application for office of Marshall at the rate of \$115.00 per month and he to furnish a horse for making the trips to lake or head of water supply and to sprinkle streets and do such repairing as he could do on streets and superintend the construction of the changes of the ditch and for putting water in our own ditch and etc.
