For example:

"Republican Senators and Congressmen need to vote to support President Trump. If they want our support they need to support our President. It is insulting to see our own Republicans putting themselves before the camera to announce their opposition to President Trump - the leader of the Republican Party. By not supporting President Trump they are not supporting us. People are mad and expect you to fix this problem, etc."

When you get a message asking for money for President Trump...go to the bottom of the message. Many times the message is from either the NRCC or the NRSC – do the same thing.

These two groups actually do good work, but it is ridiculous that they use President Trump's picture to get donations for their members, even though many in their groups do not support the President.

Let's fix this! Let them know we can hit them in the pocketbook! Get their attention!
