GRINOLD CHAPTER NEW ENGLAND DIVISION III FOOTBALL WEEKLY RANKINGS RELEASED

BUZZARDS BAY, Mass. -- The fourth Grinold Chapter New England Division III football weekly rankings of the 2016 season have been released, and Western New England holds the top spot in the poll for a fourth straight week.

The Golden Bears received 10 first place votes to top second place Salve Regina and third place Trinity in this week's rankings, as the Seahawks and Bantams collected the other first place votes. Middlebury and Husson round out the top five, followed by Amherst, Bridgewater State, Tufts, Framingham State and Wesleyan.

The New England Division III Football Poll is presented by the Jack Grinold Eastern Massachusetts Chapter of the National Football Foundation, which also serves as the title sponsor of the weekly Gold Helmet Awards presented by the New England Football Writers Association throughout the season.

A 12-member panel representing all four New England Division III playing conferences will serve as voters in this year's poll, and rankings will be released each Monday afternoon through November 14th.
