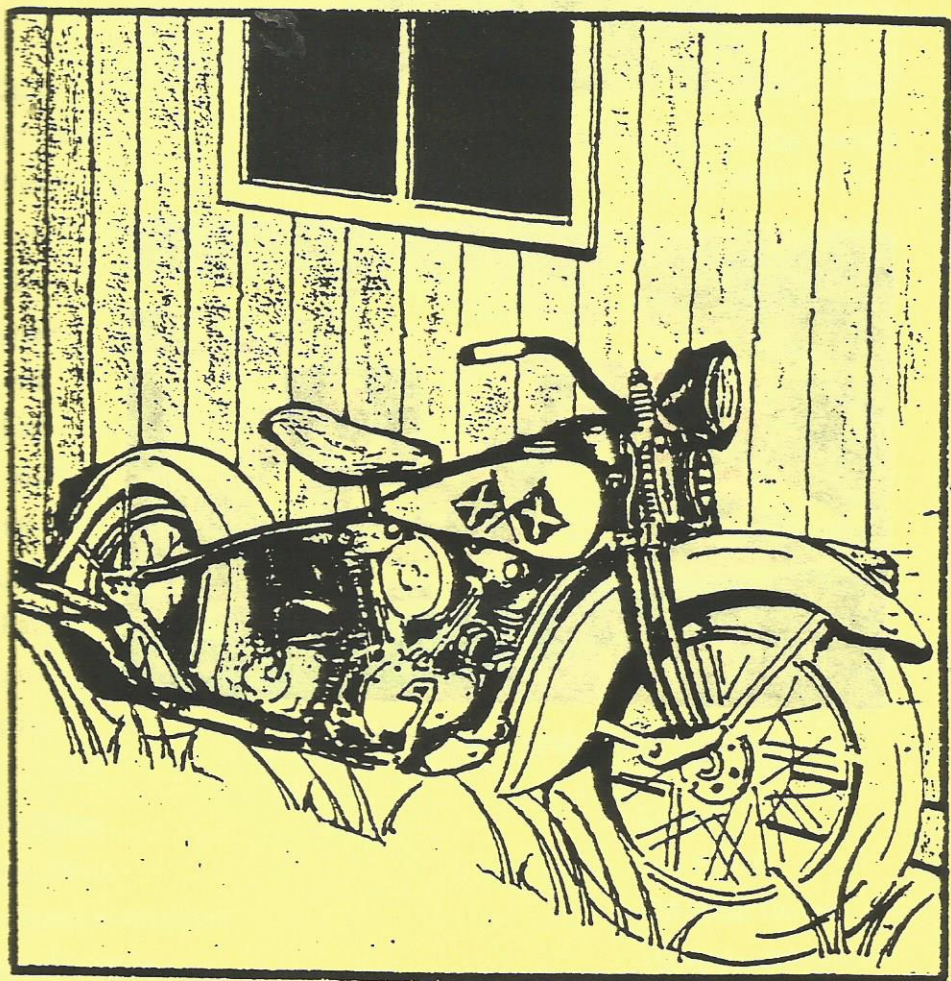
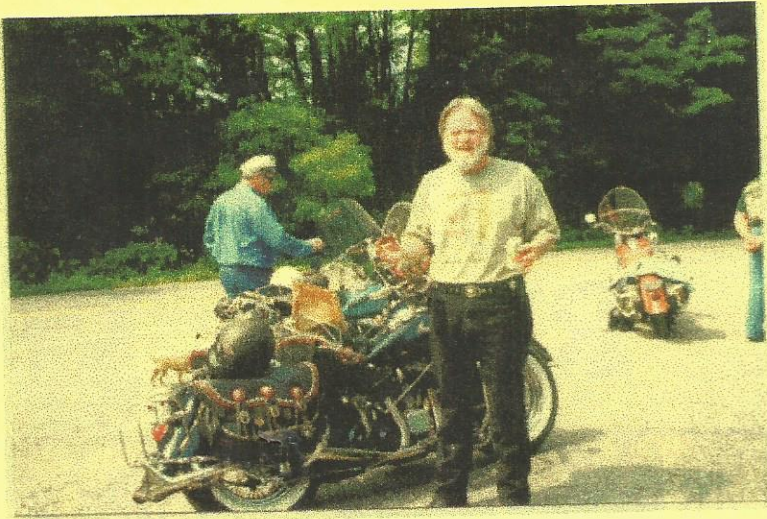

Indian eyes bike delivery in 2000



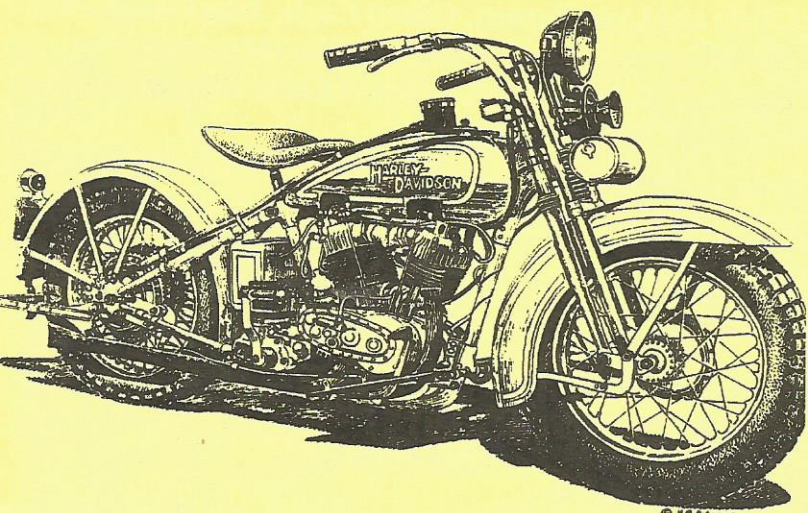
Indian Chief motorcycle was scheduled to be shown publicly for the first time Nov. 9, 1998, in Detroit.

Robert Lutz, retired vice chairman of Chrysler Corp. said he will be a consultant for a Colorado firm seeking to revive the historic Indian name.

Lutz, a known motorcycle lover who retired from the number three US auto maker, he also owns several motorcycles, including several vintage cars.

The last Indian motorcycle rolled off the assembly line at a plant in Springfield Mass., in 1953. The newest factory, which will make up to 10,000 handbuilt, premium-priced motorcycles annually, will be built on land by the Cow Creek Band of Umpqua Tribe of Indians in Myrtle Creek, Or.

Labriola expects the first motorcycles to be available for purchase in the year 2000,
