

WERNER H. F. SCHULZ SR.

1919-1990

Werner Herman Friedrich Schulz Sr., 71 of Snover, died Friday evening, May 4, at Hills & Dales Hospital, Cass City, following a brief illness.

Mr. Schulz was born in Pigeon on March 4, 1919, son of the late Henry L. and Elizabeth (Grimm) Schulz. Mr. Schulz served in the US Army during World War II, and was a member of Disabled American Veterans. He had been a farmer in the Snover area for several years.

Surviving Mr. Schulz are four sons and four daughters, Ludwig Schulz and Johann Schulz and Mrs. Douglas (Meta) Jorde, all of Deckerville, Teutobert (Ted) Schulz and Mrs. Joëy (Karoline) Collins, both of Cass City, Werner Schulz Jr. of Argyle, Mrs. Charles (Diane) Holmberg of Hawaii and Selma Schulz II of Oscoda, and 14 grandchildren.
