3-4 Leyland Cypress— Densely packed foliage is bright emerald green. Very fast growth, up to 3 feet per year in youth makes a quick solution to problem views or lack of privacy,



Viburnum 'Blue Muffin' #3— Creamy white summer flowers are followed by blue fruit in late summer. Chicago Lustre is a good pollinator. May be trimmed after flowering (leave flowers for fall berries.) Native. Deer resistant. Fruit is good for birds



Hydrangea petiolaris #3 - Vigorous climbing vine that clings to surfaces by aerial rootlets. Slow-growing shrubby habit until established, then quite vigorous, producing long, fast-growing stems. Lush green foliage is blanketed with magnificent, white lacecap blooms in summer.



Euonymus 'Silver King' #3
Excellent hedge plant with attractive, silvery white margins on glossy green leaves that adds unique color and texture to the landscape. Can be grouped to form a low screen. Highly adaptable; tolerates poor soils and heat.



Syringa 'Miss Kim' #3— 'Miss Kim' is a compact, upright cultivar which grows 4-7' tall with a similar spread. Lavender to ice blue, sweetly fragrant, single flowers are arranged in dense, terminal cluster BLOOMS!



Tradescantia 'Concord Grape' #2— 'Concord Grape' is a compact, clump-forming cultivar which typically grows to 12" tall. Purplish-blue (concord grape), three-petaled flowers (to 1.5" diameter) accented by contrasting yellow stamens are borne in terminal clusters



Hosta Sum & Substance #2
Perhaps the largest and most popular hosta. This award winner has immense leathery leaves of chartreuse that become gold as summer approaches. A bold landscape feature when accentuated by smaller bright-colored hostas and other perennials. Resists slug damage.



June 'Hosta' #1 & #2 Distinctive gold leaves with striking blue-green margins are a standout in a shaded perennial bed or woodland garden. Best color in bright shade or filtered sun, showing less variegation in deep shade.



Festuca 'Elijah Blue' #1 & #2— Outstanding, icy blue coloration to this clumping ornamental grass holds up even through the heat of summer



Dianthus #1 & #2— All Dianthus is heavily budded. Take delivery now!
