Transliteration:

Baruch atah Adonai, Eloheinu melech ha'olam, asher kid'shanu b'mitzvotav v'tsivanu l'hadlik ner shel Chanukkah.

Translation:

Blessed are You, Lord Our God, King of the universe, Who has sanctified us with His commandments and commanded us to kindle the Chanukah light.

The Second Blessing

בְּזֶמַן הַזֶּה.

Transliteration:

Baruch atah Adonai, Eloheinu melech ha'olam, sheh-asah nisim la'avoteinu ba-yamim ha-hem bazman hazeh.

Translation:

Blessed are You, O Lord our God, King of the universe, Who performed miracles for our forefathers in those days, at this time.

The Third Blessing (First Night Only)

בְּרוּךְ אַתָּה יי, אֱלֹהֵינוּ מֶלֶךְ הָעוֹלָם,
שֶׁהַחַיֵּינוּ, וְקִיָּמָנוּ, וְהַגִּיעָנוּ לְזֶמַן הַזֶּה.

Transliteration:

Baruch atah Adonai, Eloheinu melech ha'olam, sheh'heh'chey'yanu, v'kimanu, v'higi'kiyanu la'zman hazeh.

Translation:

Blessed are You, Our God, King of the universe, Who has granted us life and sustained us and brought us to this season.
