Preliminary Plan for the Desert Shores Park

1. General Park Clean up
 1. Mow grass
 2. Trim trees
 3. Pull weeds
 4. Remove dead trees
 5. Grade field
2. Repair and clean up bathroom
3. Develop site plan showing locations of soccer/football field, walking track, volleyball court, etc. for planning.
4. Repair existing park facilities, these include:
 - Picnic/Barbeque Area
 - Drinking Fountain
 - Field Lighting
 - Bleachers
 - Picnic Tables
 - Baseball Diamond
 - Basketball Court
 - Playground Equipment
5. Add new park facilities, these include:
 - Grass Soccer/Football Field
 - Volleyball Court
 - Walking Track
 - Horseshoe Pit
 - Equipment Storage
 - Snack Shack
 - Sprinkler System
