



## California State Council Candidate Information

1. Candidates may mail or email campaign material to all Chapters after April 15th.
2. All nominees may provide (at their own expense) small, inexpensive handouts for campaigning at Convention
3. Campaign materials may be distributed at the door prior to the First General Assembly, but may not be placed on chairs.
4. Campaigning is not allowed on the Convention floor. The President may elect to have the candidates, at the General Assembly on Friday, come forward and present a one minute speech on a topic of the President's choice. The President will monitor time ensuring that the Candidates receive the same one minute allotment.
5. A State Officer may not wear campaign materials for any Candidate other than herself, or campaign for any other Candidate.
6. The general membership may wear and distribute all campaign materials.
7. A State Officer or State Chairman may not submit letters supporting a Candidate for office. A Chapter or Regional Council may submit letters supporting a Candidate for Office.
8. Posters, flyers or banners may not be placed on tables in the main lobby, at pool side, on the walls, draped or flown from balconies, or any door of the Convention Hotel.
9. A Candidate may be nominated from the floor at Convention if all the requirements found under *Article VI, Qualifications* in the *California State Council Bylaws* have been met and adhering to *Bylaw Article VII, Section 2*.
