-Treasurers report:

New business

- Rookies tournament summary – Rick Conwell
 - 6 teams, could have used more concessions help (took in \$2800)
- Fall baseball/softball leagues – Matt Waldron
 - St. Peter fall league goes until first week of October
 - Rookies did not put together a team
 - Little league (6 full time kids, a few part time kids), 6 teams (2 St. Peter, Kiel, New Holstein, Holyland, Chilton), \$250 for 7 weeks
 - Motion to support from Jerry, Chops seconded, motion carried.
- Softball tournament – Mike Sell
 - \$300 for a team of ages 13+, 10 girls signed up
- East shore will push meeting off to spring, tournament will be pushed off a year - Waldron
- Softball will push meeting off to spring, will keep officers the same for this year – Ott
- Graders League Mtg, probably September – Waldron
 - Grader's account empty after trophies - Ken
- High school Mtg – Chops
 - Howards Grove won this year's final game
 - Some teams trying for Fall Ball – not Chilton
- Beuchel Stone meeting for rock out front – will saw free of charge (maybe \$1500 to engrave it, Chops will get more info)

- Equipment and uniforms - discussion
 - Typical jersey cost \$15
 - every two years for jersey
 - Should get own bat
 - General thought seems to be that each team should be provided a couple of set of catcher's gear (at least shin guards and chest protector)
 - Perhaps not needed for older players? Youngers need b/c trying a lot of new catchers
 - Will discuss more
- Doug – Dan Criter contacted about workshop for youth – mental aspects of baseball, etc
 - Craig Nennig, Collin Yelich
 - 3rd Saturday in Sept?
- Fall Work Day/Bust-up
 - Hour or two before next AC meeting
 - Work party at 5pm, burgers 6ish
- Pavilion project (\$3300 labor) for pavilion, have spent \$9,150 of \$10K budget - Doug
 - Need about \$3500 to finish pavilion down by C (soffit and ceiling)
 - Motion to finish soffit for up to \$5K – Matt Meyers, Terry Criter
 - Vote – 12 yes, 1 no
- Chops - 12x12 grilling canopy anchored in two spots, all steel construction (hold off until next year)
- We need to figure out sunshade for by A and B – discuss more in future
- Shane is stepping away from day to day responsibilities - scheduling (diamonds, volunteers, umpires) – pulling together all logins, etc., to transfer responsibilities
 - We need to find parents to get involved
 - Next registration is set up in December and needs to be done by end of January
- Terry - Gary Mathes benefit (Mary Kay) at Hilbert bowling alley (last weekend August)
 - 33 years of AC bowling Tourney - ~\$2500/yr
 - Motion to give \$500 to Mathes benefit by Mark Ott, Russ seconded, carried
- Shane suggests that we pay the umpire fees for the high school softball program
 - Motion to approve \$640 for umpires to reimburse Jay Juckem by Chops, 2nd Matt Meyers, carried
- Shane – Do we want to invite HS Girls & Boys to play some games at Nennig next year?
 - General favorable discussion
