



# 2023-2024 Faith Development / Family Catechism Registration

With the school year fast approaching, we are starting to prepare for our faith development/family catechism sessions for the coming year.

Our faith development/family catechism is for families with children ages 6-12 who have been baptized in the Catholic faith. The sessions are for

both the parent & child as our program involves interaction between parent & child. We ask that if the parent is not available, the child attend with an adult they are comfortable with. We meet bi-weekly for 1.5 hours and our program uses music, videos, slides, crafts & games to engage the children in developing their faith.

The faith development/family catechism program is the structure that helps to form the children's faith especially those that will be receiving sacraments. Please know that all children must have at least one year of faith development/family catechism prior to preparing to receive a sacrament.

Registrations for the bi-weekly sessions of faith development / family catechism for St. Augustine's or St. Lawrence O'Toole will be taking place on Sunday, September 10<sup>th</sup> from 12:15 – 1:30 pm in the church basement of St. Augustine's. Please use the door at the top of the stairs in the parking lot. Online registration forms are also available by visiting our website at <u>www.qasmoncton.com</u>, opening the tab for Faith Development and use the form for faith development. You can submit the form online or print the form (using the word or pdf document) and drop it off at our office or in the collection basket at mass.

Please note that this registration is only for our bi weekly faith development program. All families must be pre-registered in order to attend the sessions.


