

**AMELIA VILLAGE, OHIO**  
**Ordinance O-2016-24**

**AN ORDINANCE DESIGNATING DEPOSITORIES FOR ACTIVE, INACTIVE AND INTERIM DEPOSITS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

**WHEREAS**, Village Council in conformance with the Ohio Uniform Depository Act, has advertised for bids for the deposit of active, inactive and interim deposits; and

**WHEREAS**, Village Council has reviewed the bids received for the deposit of active, inactive, and interim deposits; and

**WHEREAS**, Village Council has determined that it is necessary and in the Village's best interest to appoint depositories for the designation period, now therefore,

**BE IT ORDAINED**, by the Council of Amelia Village, Clermont County, Ohio, a majority of its members concurring:

**SECTION I.** That River Hills Bank shall be designated as the depository for active, inactive, and interim deposits for Amelia Village for the designation period beginning July 2, 2016 and ending June 30, 2021.

**SECTION II.** That the Mayor and Fiscal Officer are hereby authorized and directed to enter into any necessary and proper depository agreements with River Hills Bank.

**SECTION III.** This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare of the Village, and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to approve this at the earliest possible time, in order to comply with the Ohio Uniform Depository Act and to have designated depositories for Village funds. Therefore, provided this emergency clause receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, the ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

MR. CAMPBELL moved to suspend the rules requiring three readings on three separate dates.
